Meet our Master of Ceremony





The Granby Education Foundation (GEF) is an all-volunteer, nonprofit organization committed to lifelong learning and arts for all Granby citizens. For over 20 years, the GEF has been a vital funding partner for Granby's nonprofits and schools, ensuring quality education opportunities to pursue knowledge and expand horizons. The GEF recently awarded grants for:

- Cultural exploration: Granby Racial Reconciliation's Juneteenth celebration in SBP, Kelly Lane Introduction to Native Americans program, and GMMS China interest center;
- Literacy: Kelly Lane's 24/7 Digital Library, GMHS summer reading program and author conversation;
- Financial literacy: Junior Achievement programs at Wells Road, GMMS, and GMHS;
- Nature exploration: Holcomb Tree Trail visitor kiosk educational signage and smartphone-enabled telescope at GMMS.

Most recently, the GEF gave over \$100,000 as a Special Project grant to build a TV studio and production center at GMHS which will open this fall. Previous Special Projects include the purchase of violins for the school district's Strings Program, building the Salmon Brook Ecology Center at GMMS, creating an Arts Endowment, and funding the Summer Drama Academy and Global Learning Academy.
