FontStyles - Paragraph Text

- **Text Sizing:** (*select*) Choose whether to use Site Styles or Font Styles to Manage the custom fonts. The fonts will only be visible in preview mode if using Font Styles is selected.
 - Default: Foundation Defaults

 - **Tablet+ Size:** (*number*) The size of the text relative to the default size

 - **Line Height:** (*number*) The line height of the text
 - Enable: When *Text Sizing* is set to *fontStyles*

- **Type Setting:** (*select*) Choose whether to use Site Styles or Font Styles to style the text. The fonts will only be visible in preview mode if using Font Styles is selected.
 - Default: Foundation Defaults

 - **Text Opacity:** (*number*) The Opacity of the paragraph and plain text. This setting is useful when using an image background. A slight reduction in opacity can reduce the apparent glare of your text and make it easier to read.
 - Enable: When *Type Setting* is set to *fontStyles*
 - Default: 100%
 - Min Value: 5%
 - Max Value: 100%
 - **Letter Spacing:** (*slider*) Fine tune the spacing between letters.
 - Enable: When *Type Setting* is set to *fontStyles*

 - Max Value: 2rem
 - **Word Spacing:** (*slider*) Fine tune the spacing between words
 - Enable: When *Type Setting* is set to *fontStyles*

- **Break Spacing:** (*number*) The Space between text separated by a line break

- **Custom Elements:** (*select*) You can add CSS Selectors for other elements that you want any of the Paragraph Text Settings to be applied to
