Forms of Payment: Cash, check or credit card. 4% charge on all credit card payments.

Check Liability: Any person signing a check in the state of Illinois returned "payment stopped" or "account closed" or for any reason does not clear the drawee's bank will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

Conditions of Sale: Trinity Reins Horse Sale acts as an agent only and is not responsible for the loss, damage, injury, death or illness of any animal. All horses consigned are in accordance with the laws of the state of Illinois.

Bidding Procedure: The highest bidder shall become the Buyer. The right to pass-out (P.O.) is reserved by Consignor or his representative. Any such action must be made prior to the Consignor's horse departing the auction arena. Title to the animal passes to the Buyer automatically at the final fall of the auctioneer's gavel unless such passout (P.O.) is clearly indicated immediately by Consignor, his representative, or the auctioneer. Sale Management and/or auctioneer(s) reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Bidding Disputes: If a dispute shall arise between or among two or more bidders, the auctioneer shall settle the dispute and his decision shall be absolute, final, and binding on all parties. In such case, the auctioneer has the right to reopen the bidding procedure and ask for advanced bids solely between the bidders having claimed the last bid. If there is no advance bid, the horse shall be sold to the bidder from whom the auctioneer recognized the final bid. If, for any reason, the bid should be reduced below the recognized bid at the beginning of such a dispute, the auctioneer may reopen the bidding to all bidders with the highest bidder becoming the Buyer regardless of whether or not the final bid exceeds the bid which was originally disputed.

Settlement: Settlement for any purchase must be made in full and paid directly to the sale cashier within the specified time announced prior to the commencement of the auction. Payment to any other source is prohibited and is not recognized as Settlement. All payment must be made directly to the sale cashier. Settlement for any purchase must be made for the full purchase price with U.S. Currency or with funds from a U.S. Bank in the form of a certified check, travelers chek, or bank check which has been verified and approved in advance by Sale Management. A valid driver's license and/or other approved forms of positive identification are required upon Settlemeent. Any person signing a check in the state of Illinois is liable for the full amount of the check. Any party issuing a check returned as "insufficent funds", "payment stopped" or "account closed" or a check that for any other reason does not clear the drawee's bank will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. Appropriate legal services will be obtained in whatever jurisdiction necessary to secure performance of any payment given as Settlement. All costs, including attorney's fees, incurred by Sale Management to secure performance shall be the responsibility of the party issuing such payment.

Soundness Guarante: Horses sold as sound are sold with a 72-hour soundness guarantee as defined below. All horses sold as is or needs maintenance you are buying the horse "as is" there is no guarantee. Please listen to the announcements on each horse as they come to the ring so you are clear on how the horse is being sold.

- 1) TRAVEL No visible lameness/does not limp. The horse travels soundly, hitting the ground evenly on all 4 limbs. Observable lameness is the standard for guarantee purposes. Failed flexion tests on a horse who otherwise travels sound will not be considered an unsoundness. Likewise, x-ray findings on a horse who travels sound will not be considered.
- VICES The horse does not crib/wind suck. The horse does not weave.
- WIND The horse is sound of wind with no observable breathing abnormality
- 4) EYES The horse has clear eyes with no visual impairment in either
- 5) BITE The horse does not have an overbite "parrot mouth" or an underbite "monkey mouth"
- 6) STALLIONS Stallions over the age of 18 months have both testicles descended and visible
- 7) GELDINGS Geldings are NOT ridgelings

To have the guarantee apply, you MUST be the winning bidder IN THE RING

Sale Management cannot make guarantees on things they do not witness firsthand. If a horse is a "no sale" in the ring and you follow the owner out back, discuss things, then come to a purchase agreement, THERE ARE NO SALE BARN GUARANTEES as we have no idea what was said out back between the buyer and the seller. If you want the guarantee, be the high bidder!

Should you buy a horse sold to be sound and find any of the above conditions ONLY not met, you MUST contact Sale Management within 72 hours of the sale.



"Picasso" is one of those flashy seasoned trail horses that is ready for you to start hitting the trails with this spring. He does all the great stuff that solid






