That for the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00), cash in hand paid, and other valuable consideration, the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor doth hereby grant and convey unto the Grantee subject to the timber reservation herein set out, the following described property with GENERAL WARRANTY OF TITLE:

ALL of that certain tract or parcel of land containing three (3) acres, more or less, but conveyed in gross and not by the acre, situate in White Chapel Magisterial District of Lancaster County, Virginia, adjoining the other property of the Grantee and bounded and described as follows:
