His boss was saddened by this news, as this carpenter had been a good, reliable employee for many years. He asked the carpenter if he could do him a favour and build one more house for him. The carpenter reluctantly conceded, even though his passion for building had faded. While he was building this last house, his normal work ethic faded, and his efforts were mediocre at best.

He used inexpensive and inferior materials and cut corners wherever he could. It was a poor way to finish such a dedicated career that he once had. When the carpenter was finished, his boss came to look at the house. He gave the key to the carpenter and said, "this house is a gift to you for all the hard work you have done for me over the years".

The carpenter was astonished! what a generous gift this was to receive from his boss. But if he had known he was building a house for himself, he would have made his usual efforts to create a high-quality home.

The same idea applies to how you build your life? Everyday that you wake up offers an opportunity to put your best foot forward, yet we often do some mediocre work, saving the more important things for "another" day. Then one day we find ourselves shocked that our lives aren't what we had hoped they would be. The "House" we built to live in has a lot of flaws due to lack of effort. However, you can't go back and rebuild it in a day or two. As people say, life is a do- it- yourself project.

Everyone has a retirement from our job or life. So, we should be very careful of our work or how we build our home! Your attitude and choices help build the life you will live tomorrow. So, build carefully. While your life is passing, let go of things that are out of your control. Don't carry your worries around with you every where you go, as they do nothing, but bring you down.

The parable of the builders who built their houses on sand and rock illustrates the importance of building one's life on obedience to the teachings and example of Jesus. Both the houses appear equally attractive and substantial, but their comparative stability differs. In this construction, the materials and the labour used were similar, both the houses appeared upright solid and sound. Some time the people build their lives well and wisely in terms of money, material and possessions and friends. All these are good to the human mind, but their end can be disastrous without a foundation of Rock.

In extreme conditions, a man whose house was built survived through the storm. Floods and hurricanes can damage seemingly strong houses and destroy those less strongly built. It represents the time of testing - may be a persecution, suffering or temptations which can break a weak foundation, but not a solid one. No house can be built on sand. Unfortunately, many of us are building homes that can be submerged in any rain. We cannot control the wind and rain, no matter where the house is being built. But we should hear the

warnings and build our home on a solid Rock, That of Jesus Christ! Can we rearrange our home to fit the exact measurements of carpenter's instructions? "Because if any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward." Corinthians 3:14. Let's build our houses wisely by daily obedience, faithfulness, meditation, and prayer.

We, the Salvation Army people, are saved by the blood of Jesus Christ, anointed by the Holy Spirit, and sanctified to serve others. As Paul describes in his letter to the Christians in Ephesus, 'We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do' (Ephesians 2:10, NIV).

which were placed into the hands of Jesus. Jesus thanked the heavenly Father and blessed those five small loaves of barley bread and two small fish brought by a small boy. Jesus blessed it and fed five thousand people (John 6:1-15). The boy was a small, ordinary boy. He had very little, and it was not enough to meet the huge need of feeding 5000 hungry people. But when what little he had was placed in the hands of Jesus, it was multiplied to feed all those people, and there was still more left over.

There are people around us needing to experience such a blessing, if only we would lay our lives in the hands of Jesus. Often, we hold ourselves back from taking part in God's plan of rescuing and bringing everlasting hope to those around us. There are always two reasons why we don't do what that small boy did. One, we are overprotective of what we have - we don't want to give it away. Two, we are so unaware of what gifts God has blessed us with. We think our gifts are incompatible with the demand, and so we shy away from doing what we can do for the kingdom of God.

If you look around, you will see just how much people need God's touch in their troubled lives. People are in tremendous need of peace, joy, and freedom from the struggles they go through. I believe in miracles, and if we place ourselves in the hands of Jesus, a miracle waiting to happen can be witnessed by those who are in need.

It is always good to let God use what we have, because God can bless what we can offer to him. When people witness God's wonder-working power in their lives, it gives us immense spiritual satisfaction. We realise how marvellously God has accepted us and what we offer to him. Regardless of how insignificant and inadequate it looks, and no matter how much greater is the need or the challenge we face, our God can move us beyond the limits of our strength. He is always present and always available to help and make a way. He adds his greatness to our smallest offer. He makes it greater. He adds his power and divine touch that enables us bless others.

When Jesus uses us to help others, then there are no conditions on how big or small we are in our strength, in our capacity, in our ability, in our knowledge, or in our status; none of this really matters. For Jesus will give thanks to our heavenly Father for our lives which are available to be used for others. As he did with those small loaves of barley bread and small fish given by a small boy, he will do similar miracles with our lives.

I challenge you to know Jesus and his power in your Christian life. Come to Christ as you are, and lay yourself in his blessed hand, so that he may use you and bless those around you who are seeking God in their circumstances.


May God speak into your life and make you that wonderful miracle for someone in need today, as you lay your life in the hands of Jesus.

THE GENERAL AND COMMISSIONER ROSALIE PEDDLE ATTEND ECUMENICAL SERVICE FOR COP26

ENERAL Brian Peddle and Commissioner Rosalie Peddle | (World President of Women's Ministries) joined representatives of Christian churches and organisations from around the world at a special ecumenical service in Glasgow Cathedral, UK, that was also attended by United Kingdom and Ireland territorial leaders Commissioners Anthony and Gillian Cotterill. The event was organised by Glasgow Churches Together and took place less than three miles from where the COP26 United Nations Climate Change Conference was taking place. The service was attended by guests from countries including Australia, Fiji and Zimbabwe in a show of ecumenical solidarity for global climate justice.

The General said: 'Notable and special moments occur when ecumenical colleagues stand together on an issue of mutual concern and do so on behalf of our faith communities. It was a privilege to include the voice and presence of the international Salvation Army in light of the global implications for the planet. We are stronger together.'

Some of those who took part were from nations which are already bearing the brunt of climate change. Revd Dr. Martin Johnstone, who is the COP26 Ambassador for Glasgow Churches Together, said after the event: 'It has been inspiring over the past week to meet



and learn from passionate young people committed to climate justice, and to spend time listening to the wisdom of people from some of the nations most impacted by climate change ... It was wonderful to have many of them at Sunday's service.'

Church leaders from Scotland were asked to invite young climate activists as guests, and The Salvation Army was represented by five young Salvationists from the East and West Scotland Divisions. Representatives from the Young Christian

Climate Network (YCCN), a group which has completed a 1,200-mile relay to Glasgow, were also in the congregation.

Piper Willie Park opened the service by leading a procession into the 12th-century building, and later members of the clergy walked to the tomb of St Mungo, the patron saint of Glasgow, who was buried at the site in the 7th century.

The General took part in a 'symbolic act', sharing words that were a reminder of the various 'gifts of God' while children brought these gifts — including the Bible and food and drink — to be placed on the altar.

The sermon was delivered by Revd Dr. Susan Henry-Crowe, General Secretary of the General Board of Church and Society of the United Methodist Church, who used Psalm 23 – 'The Lord is My Shepherd' – as her text.

As part of her reflection, Dr Henry-Crowe drew on the three art installations which are on display in the cathedral: Returning and Into your Arms by James Pfaff; I will Sit with You and I will Learn to Listen by Gardner and Gardner; and A Lament in Black Paint by I.D. Campbell.



Dr. Henry-Crowe said: 'For those of us who are claimed by faith... Our stories of faith acknowledge the stories of God's goodness in creating our world. We know the stories of how it began and how exquisite it was. And we have a special responsibility to listen to those living closest to the earth and seas – indigenous communities, animals, birds, fish.

We begin to hear a way forward. Return the seas to a clean home for its inhabitants. Do not pollute the waters. Return the habitation of your communities to clean and healthy spaces. Do not ruin communities for your greedy purposes.

'So - how do we get there?'

Additional contributions were given by Bishop Bill Nolan from the Catholic Church in Scotland and Most Revd Mark Strange, Primus of the Scottish Episcopal Church. Lord Wallace, the Moderator of the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland, gave a Bible reading.

Other faith leaders contributing to the service represented the All Africa Conference of Churches, the Pacific Conference of Churches, the Anglican Communion, the Roman Catholic Church, the Orthodox Church, the World Communion of Reformed Churches, the World Council of Churches, Eco-Congregation Scotland and the Scottish Church Leaders' Forum.

The General remarked: 'I had a sense that, as we stood with each other and with faith leaders from nations beyond our borders, we welcomed into our ecumenical faith participants from the



world. There was a sense of joint concern as we worshipped, prayed and articulated mutual concern for our world.'

Revd Mark Johnstone, who is the minister of Glasgow Cathedral, reflected: 'Over the past week we have welcomed the world to Glasgow. On Sunday, it was wonderful to welcome people from many nations to Glasgow Cathedral, a place where people from all over the world have gathered for centuries to meet and to worship.'

Say Yes to Christ

he Christians and believers are always tried to say YES to Christ in their life but sometimes some of them may be failed because of worldly matters. Once Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me." (Matthew 16: 24) This word is the crème of discipleship. Here the choice is voluntary; it will be made by the person. It is the individual whose wills and choices; therefore, it is the individual who must act and do the things said by Jesus. Jesus said mainly three things:

Deny himself Take up his cross Follow Him

DENY HIMSELF

The word "deny" (aparnesastho) means to disown, disregard, forsake, renounce, reject, refuse, disclaim, and do without. It means to subdue, to disregard one's self and one's interest. The real meaning of Jesus' word means that the followers are to act positively, to say Yes to Christ and no to self.

The world-famous Theologian Dr. William Barclay said on word deny is "In every moments of life say Yes to Jesus and No to self. Also, to dethrone SELF from our hearts and enthrone JESUS in the same place." Believers need to deny many things in his or her life. Deny our relationship, our rights, our authority, etc. Jesus said to his disciples, "Anyone who loves his father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves his son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me." (Matthew 10:37) Here we can see the important and seriousness of following Christ. In other time Jesus said to the crowd who were travelling with Him, "If anyone comes to me and does not hate his father and mother, his wife and children, his brothers and sisters - yes, even his own life he cannot be my disciple."(Luke 14:25, 26)

A believer or follower denies his or her personal life. We can see the word of Jesus about this, "The man who loves his life will lose it, while the man who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life." (John

12:25) "For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me and for the gospel will save." (Mark 8:35) The believers whoever are willing to lose their life for Jesus and His gospel, they will be saved by the Lord.

The word Jesus said about deny is much greater than we think. The person must deny the whole personality, not any kind of partial denial or deny whatever we are able but deny even beyond their ability.

TAKE UP HIS CROSS

When Jesus said about "take up his cross" in those days people knew that criminals are carrying their cross, sometimes long way. When the Romans came to rule in Palestine, in that time onwards the people have seen the criminals were suffering in the cross. After the judgment the Roman soldiers were giving very severe punishment to the criminals. The hardship in the cross was very terrible and fearful. The cross was the symbol of suffering and death. When any criminals were sentenced to crucify then their difficulties and suffering were started. Christ uses the word "take up his cross" means take up the person's burden and sufferings. Jesus said perfectly that those who are following Him they will be faced suffering and hardships. Not think that their life is an easy one, even Jesus suffered a lot from his birth onwards. Jesus called people to take the challenge of difficulties, sufferings and hardships. In those days the religious leaders are led a very privileged life. They have authority and power but here Jesus called people for doing services for people and lead a sacrificial life.

FOLLOW HIM

The word follow (akoloothei) means to be a follower or companion, to be a disciple.

A person who really follows Christ has no sense of regret and no desire to complain because they are not doing anything for themselves but for Christ. Then why people make complaint of their position or privileges. People are making complaint means they are forgetting about their new life then that time they are living in their old life. A life of

ambitions and desires etc for their life. But they need to remember that when they accepted Jesus as their personal Saviour, "the old has gone the new has come in their life" (2. Corinthians 5:17) That new life need to be controlled by the Lord Jesus Christ. We can see here the word of Jesus and also the sharing of Apostle Paul.

Jesus said, "In the same way, any of you who do not give up everything he has cannot be my disciple." (Luke 14:33)

Paul said, "What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish that I may gain Christ." (Philippians 3: 8)

A great danger in Christian life. A believer can only compare their life with the Lord Jesus Christ. He is only the role model for believers.

Christian life is a life of selfless services to others – those who need real services.

Jesus said, "Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mathew 20:28)

This is the Mission of the Believer and the Church. Jesus said, "The believers are the Salt of the earth, and the light of the world." (Mathew 5: 13, 14)

God bless every one of us to be a real and good believer and follower of Jesus Christ and also always say YES TO CHRIST.

limate change is a means of anguish that affects the whole humanity. Now scientists measure the rate of change as negatively affecting the whole globe. This is evident in thermal change evolved as a consequence of industrial revolution. The climate has increasingly expressed its worst effects by human activity that are causing global warming (Wikipedia).

The increase of atmospheric heat is caused by Green House Effect, a phenomenon which occurs in a glass house where plants are grown for abundance of sun light. In glass houses the plants breath out carbon dioxide gas which increase the atmospheric heat within as no gas is permitted to escape. Same phenomenon is happened on the atmosphere of earth when carbon is emitted excessively. The sunlight that held within the atmosphere generate heat but is not led out because of the accumulation of carbon and other gases produced by human activities (water vapour carbon dioxide, methane)

The carbon dioxide emission being noted for millennia till 1950 has never exceeded 300 ppm (part per million, that is carbon dioxide per million of other gases that we live with). But the current ppm is 420. Each year we put more carbon dioxide into the atmosphere than nature can remove which means the net global amount of carbon dioxide rises. In the 1960's the global growth rate of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere was 0.6 or 0.1 ppm per year. Between 2009-18 the growth rate of emission has been 2.3 ppm per year.

Human induced warming reached 1degree Centigrade in the atmosphere above preindustrial levels. Globally sea level has been rising in response to global warming. Since the past 50 years and is expected to promptly affect the coastal population. Increase of human emission rate of carbon dioxide and melting rate of ice sheets lead to decrease in the balance level of population as a result of crowding by the decrease in the total inhabitable land area due to sea level rise. If this rate of carbon emission by humans continue will continue within 10 years inhabitation of millions of people will be at risk.

Carbo hydrate and Hydro Carbon

A few years back I was deputed by the Salvation Army to be a part of a Christian Ecumenical Forum. All the denominations have their representation in their administrative body as vice presidents. I was also one among them. For their gathering once in a while I was asked to co ordinate it in Trivandrum central Church. I went around to meet all the pastors and vicars of the member congregation to invite them to the meeting, but no one came other than the parishioners. Later in an annual ecumenical gathering, I was asked to render a few words and then I disclosed the matter. If I quote my words "Here this gathering is being blessed by the presence of great bishops of the member churches. Their robes of various



colours on this arena shows the harmony of hues of a rainbow that signifies the unity of diversity in the Christian witnessing. But this not felt in the grass root level." And I disclosed what I felt in co ordinating an ecumenical gathering.

To this one of the bishops responded in this way "while a candle burns it owns a circular shade around it". I felt some thing to say but I haven't got any chance to respond to that comment. Let me take this opportunity to express what I felt there at that moment. The candle is fat made of hydrocarbon, which is the very reason of its shade. And the reason of the shade of the church on any human activity is the selfishness or greed for carbo hydrate or excess energy accumulated as fat.

Mahatma Gandhi said, "the world has enough for every one's needs, but not every one's greed" If a factory is switched on the machines will not stop, or emission will not end unless a lockdown is happened. It will continue till the product would be outdated. The owner of the factory lives anyway in a safe place but the factory keeps on polluting the area. Many new entrepreneurs are recommended and encouraged, and the carbon dioxide emission is beyond control.

More products, more profits, for more luxury, gluttonous meals, more air conditioning all results in carbon emission into the atmosphere. All entrepreneurs are self-oriented. For this they acquire land, fields of cultivation, forests and pull the common people to farthest margins.

The climate change, the global warming can be seen because of human greed for acquiring more to pacify his selfish lust. Love to the other, love to the nature is being demised. Jesus said to learn something from the nature, but we burn the nature. He enjoyed the beauty of the lilies of the field, we destroyed the field itself. 'Behold the fowls of the air, they neither sow, nor reap, nor store up in barns but your heavenly Father feeds them, Aren't you the most special of them

Yes, we are but, we think about our specialities only and we are about to lose, our business is at brink of a big trench. Is there any remedy? Yes, God created this earth and asked his special creation to tend and keep the garden. He appointed him to call them names, with his love to them he gave them names. Today we have names only since many are being extinct. The only remedy is to love each other, irrespective of class, caste, or religion. Take care for others.

n the Hebrew language the word 'dabar' means 'word' or 'speech' 'command' 'deed' or 'thing'. It also means 'to speak' or 'to promise' or 'to command'.

In the Greek language there are two terms used for the term 'the Word'. They are 'Logos' and 'Rhema'. The word 'Logos' is used primarily to denote 'the written Word'. The second term 'Rhema' used to denote 'the spoken Word'.

THE BIBLE:

The Bible is God's book. God is the Author. He is the Originator. It reveals the mind of God to the mind of men. It also reveals God's Character. It is a Unique Book. It is trust-worthy (Numbers 11:23, Ezekiel 12:25, 2 Corinth 12:20) It is profitable for instruction (Psalms 68:11). Ignorance of the Word of God is foolishness (Isaiah 29:11). It should be delivered (Numbers 11:24). The Word of God constitutes statutes and commandments (Exodus 15:26). They shall be kept (Exodus 15:26, Ezekiel 20:19)

The Bible, the Book spoken by God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit. The Words are Spirit and Life. Those who receive the words will be transformed people. May God bless you and your dear family always in all your ways.





alt-Mark :9:50 "Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt among yourselves, and be at peace with each other.if you are a follower of Jesus living the beatitudes, You have an important role to play because you are the salt of the earth. salt, to be effective, must be in contact with the meat or fish it is to preserve. To be effective, we must be involved where we work and where we live. Salt and Light share 3 things in common: both are important for survival; produce purity; reveal truth. Christians do not try to be salt and light; they ARE salt and light.

1. Salt of Turn Back

Genesis 19:26 Lot's wife looked back as the city burned, Jesus referenced her in Luke 17:32 as a picture of a Christian who loves the world. Lot heard the warning and knew it was serious. But Lots wife didn't full heartedly exit Sodom. Its applicable when we fail to act God's warning which leads to judgement. she becomes a memorial for the preservation of evil, a warning to all who might see her frozen in her half turned gaze of everyday. It is choice to look forward life giving grace or backward toward Sin to death. How will you be memorialized??

2. Salt of covenant

Numbers, God's covenant with the Aaronic priesthood is said to be a covenant of salt. .." most likely means that the covenant is "a perpetual covenant, because of the use of salt as a preservative".2 Chronicles 13:5"Ought ye not to know that the LORD God of Israel gave the kingdom over Israel to David for ever, even to him and to his sons by a covenant of salt?"When we accept Christ as our Saviour we make a

covenant with Him. We become salt for Him. (Matthew 5:13) "Ye are the salt of theearth in the Gospel of Mark. Mark 9:50 Jesus reminds his disciples to "have salt among yourselves, and be at peace with each other." In this context, "salt" is employed to express the capacity to preserve, purify, and cleanse: arrests corruption, stops decomposition, keeps off destruction, and preserves whatever is in contact with it. This is memorable for the victories of King David-1 Chronicles: 16: 37 David left Asaph and his associates before the ark of the covenant of the Lord to minister's according to each day's requirements. He followed God's commandments all the precious things were dedicated and were designed for building the Temple. Idols destroyed but the vessels of Gold dedicated. Every lust must be mortified and crucified., also brought the covenant ark to Jerusalem and the prayers were held regularly. It is easy for us to lose sight of our mission and sense of direction, if Jesus is not the heart of our mission, purpose,

plans, and activities. As disciples, He leads and we follow (Luke 9:23-26).God employs his servants in various ways some as David in

spiritual battles as Solomon in spiritual buildings that God may have the glory of all.

4. Salt of Healing

2 nd King 2:21 Many of us know the story. Water in scripture is the symbol of word, of the spirit who cleanses and refreshes and even of life. Bad water is the opposite man's futile view point pollution, weariness and death. The New Jar tells us the earthen vessels of the gospel of Lord Jesus Christ so that the power of salvation might be clearly seen. Elisha requested NOT just a jar but a new jar which denotes the believer to be regenerated, new person and new creation of God, who is the ambassador and priest of God to proclaim God's salvation through Jesus Christ.

Dear readers Are we living seasoned with the life of Christ, living purposefully, sacrificially revealing the person and love of Christ to a sick and lost? Are we involved in our society for good or a part of problem? Are we making unity and harmony in our church? One of the greatest hindrances to evangelism is disharmony. So let's be a new vessel, full of salt, seasoned and poured out for a sick and dying world. Modern medical field still uses salt for healing bodies, infact we couldn't survive without salt.

and 7 living alone, total 9 officers joined this fellowship. They gave thanks to God for the protection in the time of COVID - 19.



SONG WRITER JOHNSON OATMAN, JR.




ohnson Oatman, Jr., son of Johnson and Rachel Ann Oatman, was born near Medford, N. J., April 21, 1856. His father was an excellent singer, and it always delighted the son to sit by his side and hear him sing the songs of the church.

Outside of the usual time spent in the public schools, Mr. Oatman received his education at Herbert's Academy, Princetown, N. J., and the New Jersey Collegiate Institute, Bordentown, N. J. At the age of nineteen he joined the M.E. Church, and a few years later he was granted a license to preach the Gospel, and still later he was regularly ordained by Bishop Merrill. However, Mr. Oatman only serves as a local preacher.

For many years he was engaged with his father in the mercantile business at Lumberton, N. J., under the firm name of Johnson Oatman & Son. Since the death of his father, he has for the past fifteen years been in the life insurance business, having charge of the business of one of the great companies in Mt. Holly, N. J., where he resides.


He has written over three thousand hymns, and no gospel song book is considered as being complete unless it contains some of his hymns.
