

# General Scheduling Information

The information is provided so that one may continue to take a music class all four years.

## 1) **Make taking music a priority when you talk with counselor**

There is room in both of these scenarios to take music classes all four years

Nearly all Colleges want to see you take: 4 years English 3 years Math 3 years Social Studies 3 years of Science 2 years of World Language <b>4 years of Band</b>	Elite Colleges want to see you take: 4 years English 4 years Math 3 years Social Studies 3 years of Science 3-4 years of World Language <b>4 years of Band</b>
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You don't have to take Social Studies, Science, and Math all four years.

## 2) **Do I have to take all AP courses?**

No. You don't have to take all AP classes all the time. Investigate what you enjoy doing and is there an AP class for what you enjoy doing? Also investigate whether the colleges you are interested in accept AP credit. Many colleges don't and many more are changing their views on AP and are not accepting AP credit.

## 3) **How do I take care of the Consumer Ed requirement?**

Marching Band / PE Waiver – frees up a semester per year for music class

Summer School – frees up a semester for music class

Zero Hour PE – frees up a class during the year for music class

Economics or AP Economics (in Social Studies)

Consumer Management (in Business & it also takes care of Applied Arts requirement)

## 4) **How do I take care of the Speech requirement?**

Marching Band / PE Waiver – frees up a semester per year for music class

Summer School – frees up a semester for music study

Zero Hour PE – frees up a class during the year for music class
