### NOTES

**Note 1:** Subsection 31(4) of the *TDG Act* stipulates that any non-compliance with the conditions of this certificate causes the provisions of the *TDG Act* and *TDG Regulations* to apply as though this equivalency certificate did not exist.

**Note 2:** This temporary certificate provides no regulatory relief other than specifically stated herein. Therefore, all other requirements of the *TDG Act* and the *TDG Regulations* apply.

## CONDITIONS

This temporary certificate authorizes Call2Recycle Canada Inc., the participants in the program Call2Recycle or the consumers participating in battery recalls to handle, offer for transport or transport, and authorizes any person to handle or transport on behalf of Call2Recycle Canada Inc., the participants in the program Call2Recycle or the consumers participating in battery recalls, by road or railway vehicle, or by vessel on a domestic voyage, dangerous goods that are:

- UN3090, LITHIUM METAL BATTERIES (including lithium alloy batteries), Class 9,
- UN3091, LITHIUM METAL BATTERIES CONTAINED IN EQUIPMENT (including lithium alloy batteries), Class 9,
- UN3480, LITHIUM ION BATTERIES (including lithium ion polymer batteries), Class 9,
- UN3481, LITHIUM ION BATTERIES CONTAINED IN EQUIPMENT (including lithium ion polymer batteries), Class 9,

in a manner that does not comply with:

- Part 3 (Documentation) of the *TDG Regulations*, and
- Part 6 (Training) of the *TDG Regulations*,

If the following conditions are met:

- (a) The battery is damaged or defective and does not conform to subsection 2.43.1(2) of Part 2 (Classification) of the *TDG Regulations*;
- (b) The battery is transported in accordance with the requirements of Special Provision 137 of Schedule 2 of the *TDG Regulations*;
- (c) The outer means of containment is stored away from heat;
- (d) The outer means of containment is durably and legibly marked on a contrasting background with:
  - (i) the Class 9, lithium battery label, illustrated in the Appendix of Part 4 of the *TDG Regulations*, the corresponding UN number and shipping name;
  - (ii) the words “**Damaged/Defective Lithium Ion Batteries**” or “**Damaged/Defective Lithium Metal Batteries**”;
  - (iii) the words “**Forbidden for transport by aircraft – road, rail or marine shipment only**”; and
  - (iv) the temporary certificate number “**TU 0660**”;

- (e) Detailed closure, packing, and shipping instructions are provided to individuals preparing shipments under the conditions of this Temporary Certificate; and
- (f) A paper or electronic copy of this temporary certificate accompanies the dangerous goods during transport and must be provided to an inspector immediately upon request.

**Explanatory Note**

This temporary certificate authorizes Call2Recycle Canada Inc., the participants in the program Call2Recycle or the consumers participating in battery recalls to handle, offer for transport or transport, and authorizes any person to handle or transport on behalf of Call2Recycle Canada Inc., the participants in the program Call2Recycle or the consumers participating in battery recalls, dangerous goods that are:

- UN3090, LITHIUM METAL BATTERIES (including lithium alloy batteries), Class 9,
- UN3091, LITHIUM METAL BATTERIES CONTAINED IN EQUIPMENT (including lithium alloy batteries), Class 9,
- UN3480, LITHIUM ION BATTERIES (including lithium ion polymer batteries), Class 9,
- UN3481, LITHIUM ION BATTERIES CONTAINED IN EQUIPMENT (including lithium ion polymer batteries), Class 9,

in a manner that does not comply with Part 3 (Documentation), Part 6 (Training) of the *TDG Regulations*. This temporary certificate may be needed to conduct a recall of a lithium metal, or lithium-ion battery, or a consumer product containing a lithium metal, or lithium-ion battery. These batteries are either damaged or defective.
