Job Requirements:

- Complete a training class in the operations of the espresso machine and how to make specialty drinks (*let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance. Proverbs 1:5*): Make a diligent effort to learn required and additional tasks
- Stock Cafe supplies
- Clean-up and set-up according to the lists provided
- Maintain a clean, safe dining area
- Assist in other areas, supporting each other as a team (*for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose. Philippians 2:3*): Carry out all duties in a respectful, godly manner
- Other duties as assigned
