

During the week we have 20 - 25 class sessions, and a major field trip to historical sites such as the Lexington Green where the "shot heard 'round the world" was fired, or the Concord Bridge and its famous sculpture of the Minuteman just at the instant where he lets go of his plow to shoulder his rifle.

Recreational activities range from chess to sports, plus swimming, canoeing, and kayaking on the lake, optional field trips, and hikes. The camp newspaper, by and for the campers, is normally distributed at the last break of the day.

Camp Constitution was formed in 2009 on a 39-year-old foundation. We are volunteers in unincorporated association.


