## Gary Allen — R.I.P.

Conservative author and journalist Gary Allen died of a liver ailment November 29th in the Memorial Medical Center in Long Beach, California. Allen, who was 50, was a graduate of Stanford University and a former teacher of high-school history and English. An admitted "ADA-type liberal" who set out to "prove the conservative anti-Communists wrong" about the conspiratorial theory of history, Allen became instead one of the most articulate defenders of that theory.

He was the author of eight books, including Communist Revolution in the Streets, The Rockefeller File, Richard Nixon: The Man Behind the Mask, and None Dare Call It Conspiracy, which sold more than five million copies. Mr. Allen was a contributing editor to American Opinion magazine for 18 years and to the Conservative Digest. He is survived by his wife Barbara and four children.
