


On August 2nd 1610 Henry Hudson entered the Baylater named after him, The Hudson Bay.



The Badge of Military Merit was first announced in General George Washington's general orders to the Continental Army issued on August 7, 1782 at the Headquarters in Newburgh. Designed by Washington in the form of a purple heart, it was intended as a military order for soldiers who exhibited, "not only instances of unusual gallantry in battle, but also extraordinary fidelity and essential service in any way." This was the first decoration for common soldiers and broke the European tradition of awarding only officers. The Badge of Military Merit was replaced by the Purple Heart. \*


The bears were hybernating this week. Mr. Hoderny was the lonely bear. Addison and Jessica Whitworth were today's runners.★


