Alex Newman



Dr. Eugene M. Long


Born in Augusta, Georgia, his father was a WWII veteran, having participated in the Normandy Invasion on D-Day and seeing continual combat for the remainder of the war.

Jonathan Alexandre, J.D., is Director of Public Policy for Liberty Counsel and Liberty Counsel Action in Washington, DC. In this position, Alexandre consults with and advises law and policy makers, including nonprofit and advocacy groups at the federal, state, and local levels across the nation, regarding issues on religious freedom, the sanctity of life, marriage and the family, foreign and domestic policies, Israel, and the Middle East. In addition, Alexandre oversees internships in the Washington, DC office. The internship opportunities are available to students from around the country who are interested in law, policy, and Israel.

He also retains an active role assisting the Massachusetts Family Institute (MFI) in public policy. Previously, Alexandre was Assistant General Counsel and Public Policy Coordinator for the MFI in Boston. In this role, he provided counsel for MFI's mission in the legal and legislative arenas to advance the sanctity of life, the dignity of traditional marriage, and religious liberty in the Commonwealth. Alexandre developed the Massachusetts Attorney Resource Council, a network of pro-family Massachusetts attorneys. Before his tenure at MFI, Alexandre worked for the Mayor of Worcester, Massachusetts, The Jerusalem Center of Public Affairs in Jerusalem, Israel as a Scholar in Residence, and the United States Army's Judge Advocate General's Legal Center and School. Alexandre earned his undergraduate degree from Ana Maria College in Political Science and Government and received his Juris Doctor from Liberty University School of Law. He is also a gifted singer whom we hope to hear at our evening campfires. ★

Yes there are daily cabin inspections. Obviously, the inspectors are looking for clean and tidy quarters, however, the returning campers will show you how to really rack up the points. Traditionally, the campers who most creatively capture the spirit of our camp through theme based decorations, tasteful humor, and patriotism score big in the contest. Make it fun! Hint: The inspectors are not above the occasional bribery attempt. Points from 0-10 are awarded each day for your participation in this contest. At the end of the week the cabin with the most points will get "FREE PIZZA" during the pizza party.

Newspaper Participation

The newspaper is looking for lecture reviews, free-time fun stories, campfire tidbits, lake-front occurrences etc. Who, what, where, how, why and when are the concepts to keep in mind as you write your stories. Last year the newspaper was lacking in details on the following recurring events: Flag participants including Scripture reading and grace before meals. Also, don't forget polar bear and morning run as well as campfire participants. We also want to see direct quotes from our speakers.

Your cabin will earn 0-2 points each day for your submissions during the week. Your participation will require submissions from multiple campers on multiple topics. Quality, quantity, number of submitters and diversity of topics are the four criterion on which your bonus will be awarded 0-.5 points in each criterion per day. If multiple cabins cover the same topics, the Editor of the newspaper may combine the stories and weave the details but credit will be awarded whether the story is used or not. The bonus is 1/6 or 17% of your total points. Make sure all newspaper submissions have your name and cabin number on them so your team gets credit for the contribution. The bonus will be a running total updated daily.

Program Director/Instructor Ruth is the first and only program director for our camp. As such, she establishes the camp curriculum and develops the preassessment and post-assessment tests with the assistance of other staff members. She lives in Grand Rapids, MI where she runs an American Opinion Bookstore.*

Lord Christopher Monckton

Christopher Monckton, Third Viscount Monckton of Brenchley, has held positions with the British press and in government and as a press officer at the Conservative Central Office. He is a policy advisor to The Heartland Institute. Lord Monckton was Special Advisor to Margaret Thatcher as U.K. Prime Minister from 1982 to 1986.

In 1986 he was among the first to advise the prime minister that "global warming" caused by carbon dioxide should be investigated. Two years later she set up the Hadley Centre for Forecasting: but she, like him, later changed her view.

On leaving 10 Downing Street, he established a successful specialist consultancy company, giving technical advice to corporations and governments. The first of his two articles on global warming in The Sunday Telegraph in November 2006 crashed its website after attracting 127,000 hits within two hours of publication.



A speech by Lord Monckton to 1,000 citizens of St. Paul, Minnesota in October 2009, in which he drew public attention to a then little-known draft plan by the U.N. to establish an unelected world government at the (now-failed) climate summit at Copenhagen in December 2009, received 1,000,000 YouTube hits in a week — thought to be the fastest-ever YouTube platinum for a political speech. Some five million have now seen the presentation on various websites. * https://www.heartland.org/

Mrs. Bonnie Wilder

Mrs. Bonnie Wilder spends her summers in Wayne, Maine and her winters in Beverly Hills Florida. She taught music in the Chelmsford, MA public schools for 30 years before she retired in 2004. In her retirement, the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) appointed her the Constitution Week Chair of the State of Maine. As such, she created child-friendly materials and lessons to teach young children about the Constitution. Mrs. Wilder is now the



Educational Resource Chair for Maine DAR, a position created by the National Society of the DAR to assist teachers and youth leaders. The new resources allow anyone to use lessons submitted by and for teachers, which feature American history, civics and patriotism, in addition to materials for September 17-23 Constitution Week studies. *

Dr. Willie Soon

Dr. Soon earned his bachelor's and master's degrees in science and his Ph.D. in aerospace engineering from the University of Southern California. He was a speaker at the Heartland Institute's 9th International Conference on Climate Change, a gathering of many of the world's top climate sci-



entists and researchers who challenge the IPCC's increasingly discredited claim that human activity is causing a global crisis that demands draconian global regulations under an increasingly powerful United Nations.

Born in Malaysia, Dr. Soon immigrated to the US in 1980. In 2004, he received the Petr Beckmann Award for outstanding contributions to the defense of scientific truth. ★
