American Police State Rising

In part 1 we laid out the 7 steps necessary to the creation of a National Police State in the United States. In part 2 we shall look at how those 7 steps are evolving today.

1. **CRISIS.** On September 11, 2001, a series of attacks targeted the World Trade Center and the Pentagon.

This was the single deadliest day in U.S. law enforcement history. Seventy-two police officers were killed responding to the terrorist attacks in New York City and Washington, D.C.

 AID. Immediately following the 9/11 attacks, pooling its vast resources, the federal government provided aid through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). All commercial and non-commercial flights were grounded.

Units of the U.S. National Guard were deployed and stationed alongside New York City and Port Authority police at major travel and transportation centers, such as New York's Penn Station, Port Authority Bus Terminal, and Grand Central Station.

3. **LEGISLATION**. Within a little over a month after the attacks, Congress passed and President George W. Bush signed the Patriot Act, which authorized warrantless searches and wiretaps, as well as many other invasions of privacy.

The following year, in November 2002, Congress passed and President Bush signed the Homeland Security Act, which authorized the creation of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

Many months earlier, on March 11, 2002, President Bush had signed Homeland Security Presidential Directive 3, which created the Homeland Security Advisory System. Moreover, post 9/11, Congress passed other measures providing funds to the DHS for assisting local police and firefighters with training and exercises, standards and guidelines, and financial grants for hiring additional personnel and buying emergency equipment.

4. **PROPAGANDA**. Many radical groups emerged with a campaign against local police, such as the ANSWER coalition, New Black Panther Party, Party for Socialism and Liberation, Revolutionary Communist Party, and the Universal Zulu Nation. In 2011, the Party for Socialism and Liberation officially stated:

"Police brutality is a symptom of the capitalist disease. Socialist revolution is the cure."

5. **INDOCTRINATION**. In order to share information and work closely with local law enforcement, the Department of Homeland Security has created Fusion Centers.

Fusion Centers are information and analysis dispensers that serve as transmission belts from the federal government to state, local, tribal, and territorial governments and private sector partners for the gathering and sharing of threat-related information. Since their creation in 2003, at least 72 known fusion centers have been set up throughout the country.

One such fusion center release the MIAC report for distribution to local police stating in part:

Rightwing extremism in the United States can be broadly divided into those groups, movements, and adherents that are primarily hate-oriented... and those that are mainly antigovernment, rejecting federal authority in favor of state or local authority, or rejecting government authority entirely. It may include groups and individuals that are dedicated to a single issue, such as opposition to abortion or immigration.

- 6. IMPLEMENTATION. Congress has also continued to provide funds to the Department of Homeland Security and the Office of Justice Programs for direct financial aid to local police as well as providing them with real or questionable threat intelligence.
- 7. **NATIONALIZATION**. On July 2, 2008, while campaigning for the office of president, then-U.S. Senator Barack Obama told a crowd of supporters in Colorado:

We cannot continue to rely only on our military in order to achieve the national security objectives that we've set. We've got to have a civilian national security force that's just as powerful, just as strong, just as well-funded.

Other instruments of implementation include:

- Federal Protective Service (FPS)
- Ready Reserve Corps (Established in Obamacare)

While it is impossible to establish a date upon which a national police force would be completely installed, it is abundantly clear that the process is underway. ★

★ POLITICS ★ OF ★ SCIENCE ★

On July 21, 1925, the so-called "Monkey Trial" ended in Dayton, Tennessee, with John T. Scopes found guilty of violating state law for teaching Darwin's Theory of Evolution. Today is the 95th anniversary of that decision; a decision that was later overturned. To be more accurate, however, Scopes was charged for teaching that man's origin was from a lower life-form. No other aspects of the Theory of Evolution violated the Butler Act under which he was charged.

But why is the trial (widely accepted as "the Trial of the Century") important today? It is especially important today because the propaganda around this case, which is derived greatly from the play and subsequent movie "Inherit The Wind", provided much of the impetus for the main stream opinion that science offers more to society then religion. It gave science an edge in the battle between religion and reason that was initiated most distinctly during the enlightenment period.

While considering this anniversary, my attention was drawn to the Covid-19 pandemic. Nowhere is it more evident that science dictates politics more than religion in the modern world. It is the scientists that are making all the decisions. Consider, in Pennsylvania, state liquor stores were open and deemed essential while churches and worship services were shutdown. The rules of our Governors were justified, not on constitutional considerations, but by *scientific facts*.

This reminded me of an article in the April 21, 2014 issue of The New American Magazine entitled, When Science Treads on Religion. Allow me to insert a few paragraphs from the article here:

[Yet even] Science at its best, practiced by the most faith-filled researchers, cannot even begin to fill religion's shoes. The reason why was explained beautifully by William Jennings Bryan in a statement released to the media in the wake of the 1925 Scopes Trial:

Science is a magnificent force, but it is not a teacher of morals. It can perfect machinery, but it adds no moral restraints to protect society from the misuse of the machine. It can also build gigantic intellectual ships, but it constructs no moral rudders for the control of [the] stormtossed human vessel. It not only fails to supply the spiritual element needed but some of its unproven hypotheses rob the ship of its



compass and thus endanger its cargo. In war, science has proven itself an evil genius ... thus making the battlefield three times as bloody as it was before; but science does not teach brotherly love.... If civilization is to be saved from the wreckage threatened by intelligence not consecrated by love. it must be

saved by the moral code of the meek and lowly Nazarene. His teachings, and His teachings alone, can solve the problems that vex the heart and perplex the world.

Without a doubt, unless science takes that greatest of leaps across the great divide and learns to observe the spiritual world as it now observes germs and bacteria — and can also thus read divine law — it will never be able to do religion's work. For, science only tells us what we can do; not what we should. Morals aren't revealed through microscopes; principles don't reside in Petri dishes. One cannot prove that murder is wrong scientifically. Oh, sure, people have balked at this assertion, at which point we'd go on that materialist merry-go-'round. They might say, "But murder hurts others," to which I'll respond, "Prove that it's wrong to hurt others"; they might follow up with, "Well, it hurts society and can lead to social breakdown," and I'll retort, "Prove that is wrong." And 'round and 'round it goes, and where it stops the thinker knows: with the axiom that Truth exists. And Truth properly understood as universal, eternal, and unchangeable implies God.

And so as the technocrats continue to gain fame and power in modern society, it may serve you well to remember the words of William Jennings Bryan. Keep your constitution close and your faith closer. While science can provide a degree of progress in day to day life, it can also present a myriad of ethical questions which science itself is ill equipped to handle. Keep in mind, no creature has a higher intellect than Satan himself. But his intellect would hardly qualify him as an expert in moral theology. **




