Field Trip: Calvin Coolidge Homestead



CALVIN COOLIDGE IS THE ONLY PRESIDENT BORN ON THE FOURTH OF JULY.

John Calvin Coolidge was born in Plymouth Notch, Vermont, on July 4, 1872—giving him the distinction of being the only president born on the fourth of July. (Three of the first five U.S. presidents died on the Fourth of July, however: Thomas Jefferson and John Adams in 1826, and James Monroe in 1831.)

COOLIDGE WAS ELECTED TO POLITICAL OFFICE THE SAME YEAR HE OPENED HIS OWN LAW FIRM.

Coolidge was an engaged student. He graduated with honors from Amherst College in 1895, then earned his law degree. After passing the bar, he opened a firm in Northampton, Massachusetts, in 1898, and was elected to the town's city council. That modest office led to an escalating interest in politics that led to his election as governor of the state in 1918.

A POLICE STRIKE MADE COOLIDGE A HOUSEHOLD NAME.

In 1919, Coolidge faced his biggest challenge yet as a politician when a police strike led to panic and violence in the streets of Boston. After sending in the state guard to quell the tension, Coolidge admonished the officers for leaving their posts. That hard-line stance impressed the public at large, and by 1920, he was an easy pick for a vice-presidential nomination on the Republican ticket next to presidential nominee Warren G. Harding. When Harding died just two years into his term, Coolidge found himself in the Oval Office.

COOLIDGE'S OWN FATHER SWORE HIM IN.

In a moment that had never transpired before and has never been repeated since, Coolidge was sworn into the presidential office by his own father, also named John Calvin Coolidge. The pair found themselves together while the younger Coolidge was visiting his father in Vermont. News arrived of Harding's sudden death, which prompted Coolidge Senior, a notary public, to swear in his son in the middle of the night.

COOLIDGE WAS POPULAR FOR DOING NOTHING.

In contrast to presidents who lent a heavy hand in American affairs, Coolidge captured the public's favor by essentially doing nothing. He allowed businesses to prosper by minimizing government interference and satisfied voters who believed bureaucracy had become too overwhelming. He's quoted as saying that he spent much of his presidency "avoiding the big problems."

GOVERNOR COOLIDGE & THE GREAT MOLASSES FLOOD.

In his second week as governor, a giant tank containing over two million gallons of molasses burst in a tidal wave of syrup, over 25 feet high, and moving at over thirty miles per hour through the north end of Boston. Unable to outrun or swim in the molasses, twenty-one Bostonians were drowned. A number of horses were also trapped and died in the tragedy.

COOLIDGE AN "ISOLATIONIST".

As president, he promoted a non-interventionist foreign policy. His detractors labeled him an isolationist for following the advice of George Washington. In his farewell address, our first president advised that America should avoid foreign wars and "entangling alliances."

COOLIDGE, A MAN OF FEW WORDS

Coolidge was a man of few words, and was nicknamed "Silent Cal". Sometimes during interviews he would simply answer questions, "Yes" or "No". Once at a party, someone approached him and said, "my friend bet me I couldn't get three words out of you." The president replied, "You Lose."

A group of campers went in a small caravan of vehicles to visit the President Calvin Coolidge State Historic Site. One of the items of interest involved a beverage called Moxie which was Calvin Coolidge's favorite soft drink. It was designed to be a medicine and is made from Gentian root. The drink was named after the inventor's friend Lieutenant Moxie. You may not have known about this soft drink, but the word moxie, describing the qualities of courage, daring, and energy—as in "This gal's got moxie,"—is an offshoot of advertising jingles developed to market the drink. Dr. Long and Professor Willie Soon were spotted getting their moxie on! So if you see them around, be sure to ask them about their experience and see if they can describe the unique and unusual flavor of Moxie. ★

US History: American Values Through Coinage

You Won't Believe What I Found

Last Evening Mr. Tom Moor was scheduled to deliver a talk on US History: American values through coinage. I've been collecting coinage for over 40 years and have some interesting pieces. I'd like to tell a little story which I hope will demonstrate the surprise and exhilaration that can come through numismatics.

I was introduced to coin collecting at a young age by my maternal grandmother's nephew, Rocco. "The Rock", as we called him, was a WWII veteran. He was wounded in the Battle of the Bulge and rescued by Patton's 3rd Army.

Rocco started all the kids in the family with penny albums in the mid-1970s. With me, the hobby stuck and I now continue to maintain his collection and have added my own to it.

Our story picks up in 1993 in upstate New York. During that year, the new CoinStar machines were being rolled out (pun intended) into neighborhood grocery stores. Patrons could empty their coinage jars into the machine and receive store credit at the cash register to help pay the grocery bill.

I was long in the habit of checking my change and stowing away the pieces that interested me and this particular year, older coins and silver pieces were showing up significantly more often than normal. I was finding silver almost every week whereas in past years I would be lucky to run across a single example in my change. I assume the machines were recirculating old dusty coins.

Early in 1994, I found myself in a convenience store making a quick purchase. Imagine my surprise as I stared into my hand and saw a 1909 S Lincoln Cent in my change. The clerk must have seen my eyes light up as I leaned into my palm to get a better look. "Is there a problem sir"? "No. No problem at all", I beamed. When I got back to the apartment I added that baby into Rocco's #1 Collection Album.

As an aside, 1909 was the first year of Issue for the Lincoln cent. It was introduced to celebrate the Centennial Anniversary of the birth of our 16th President, Abraham Lincoln. How's that for history through coinage? The "S" is a mint mark indicating that this specimen was minted in San Francisco. Back then, the reverse of the coin had wheat branches left and right of the words ONE CENT and they are affectionately referred to as "Wheat Cents" or "Wheaties". In 1959, the reverse was changed to instead show an image of the Lincoln Memorial Monument that stands in Washington, DC. This series is referred to as

"Lincoln Memorials". Current cents depict a shield and are called "Shield Cents".

Our story picks back up in the year 2020. Some 26 years after having acquired this coin and having slid it into Rocco's #1 coin album a rather unexpected event occurred. You see, the coin in question was well worn and I was unable to discern all the details of the coin. I was elated to have this rarity though.

Over the years I have continued to collect and keep all my "wheaties" hoping to get a 1931S or 1922 plain to fill another one of Rocco's album holes. So I decided it was time to go through the wheat backs and see if I had any double dies or other errors amongst them.

I bought a usb microscope which lets me see all the fine details of a coin. They're cheap now, just 30 bucks on Amazon. Just out of curiosity, I pulled the 1909S out of the book and flipped her over.

Under the microscope, I saw the faint letters V.D.B. I couldn't make that out under a magnifying glass. (It's in poor condition, referred to as a cull.)

So that fateful trip into the convenience store yielded, not a 1909-S (1.28 million minted) rarity, but a super rare (484,000 minted) 1909-S VDB. I promptly slid that baby over into the next hole of the album. I was in shock. It is truly amazing to have actually acquired a 1909S VDB in circulation 85 years after it was issued.

What is a VDB cent? The VDB are the initials of the engraver, Victor D. Brennan. The coins were modified to remove his initials shortly after it was introduced. Therefore, in 1909 you can have one of 6 varieties: Lincoln cents issued in Philadelphia or San Francisco and either with the initials or without. Also, the last Indian head pennies were minted in SF and Philly that year for two additional varieties.

The 1909 S VDB penny is indeed one of the most expensive regular-strike (non-error) rarities of modern U.S. coins. It is also one of those coins that has seen virtually nothing but upward trends in values for the last several decades.

The value of a 1909 S VDB cent is around \$700-800 in Good condition, and upwards of \$1,800-2,000 in uncirculated grades. There have been some badly worn, even damaged, 1909 S VDB pennies that can be occasionally found on eBay and in coin dealers' catalogs. Yet, even these unsightly pieces often go for at least a few hundred dollars. ★

Scientists Use AI to Predict Sunspot Cycles

For the first time, scientists have used artificial intelligence not only to predict sunspots but also to correct the incomplete record of past sunspot activity.

A new paper just published in *Advances in Space Research* by Dr Victor Velasco Herrera, a theoretical physicist at the National Autonomous University of Mexico, Dr Willie Soon, an award-winning solar astrophysicist at the Harvard-Smithsonian Center for Astrophysics, and Professor David Legates, a climatologist at the University of Delaware and former director of the U.S. Global Change Research Program, predicts that the new 11-year solar cycle that has recently begun will show near-record low sunspot activity that will last until mid-century.

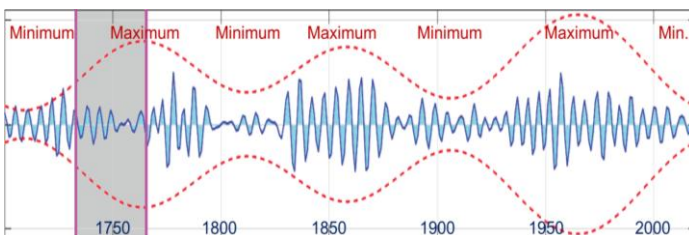
Both Dr Soon (in 2004) and Dr Velasco Herrera (in 2008) had previously published papers speculating that the first half of the 21st century would be a period of unusually few sunspots, potentially slowing the rate of global warming

Sunspots matter. When there are many sunspots and the Sun is active, there is a danger that a strong solar ejection directed towards the Earth could damage or even destroy the thousands of satellites on which the world depends for everything from radio, telephone, television and internet communications to monitoring the climate and observing the farthest reaches of the universe.

Worse, a really strong solar storm could damage the largely unshielded terrestrial electricity grid. Most power lines and transformers are above ground and thus acutely vulnerable. Solar panels, too, could have their lives shortened by intense solar radiation.

The three scientists taught a machine-learning algorithm how to recognize underlying patterns and cycles in the past 320 years' sunspot record. The algorithm then discovered a hitherto-unnoticed interaction between the 5.5-year solar half-cycles (blue) and the 120-year Gleissberg double cycles (red dotted lines) which allowed it to confirm the earlier predictions of a quiet half-century to come - predictions which are now shared by solar physicists.

That interaction between the two periodicities led the algorithm to indicate that from the 1730s to the 1760s, early in the modern sunspot record (the gray band below), sunspots appear to have been under-recorded: as the 120-year cycle approached its maximum amplitude, sunspots should have been more numerous than reported at the time.

The Sun painted by a machine-learning algorithm

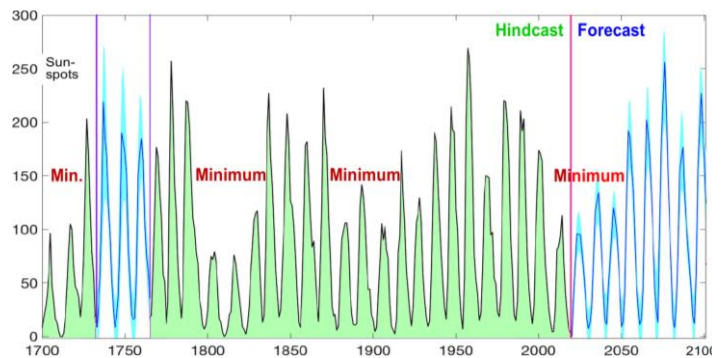


The algorithm then predicted the sunspots from 2021 to 2100. It suggests that the current low solar activity is likely to continue until 2050:

Dr Velasco Herrera said: "Not everyone agrees with our expectation that solar activity will continue to be low for another three solar cycles. A paper in *Solar Physics* by Dr Scott McIntosh of the U.S. National Center for Atmospheric Research, says the coming solar cycle will be unusually active, with a peak sunspot number of 233, compared with our estimate of less than 100. Place your bets in the Battle of the Solar Cycles!"

Dr Soon said, "The machine-learning algorithm, with its interesting interplay between the very short 5.5-year cycle and the long 120-year cycle,

confirms our results of 10-15 years ago suggesting that the next three or four solar cycles will be comparatively inactive. This is the first time that the twin problems of hindcasting incomplete past records and forecasting the future have been combined in a single analysis."



The Sun may be quiet for half a century

Dr Legates said: "President Trump realized the importance of space weather, and particularly of the Sun, in influencing global climate. It was he who signed the October 2020 ProSwift Act into law to assist in studying and forecasting space weather. Given the history of previous periods of comparative solar activity, the weather may get a little cooler between now and 2050. If we are right, our electricity grids and our satellites should be safe until then." ★

How should we deal with that?

Ephesians 4:30-32 "And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. 31 Let all bitterness [rather comprehensive], and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: 32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you."

There is a connection made between grieving the Holy Spirit and maintaining a heart of bitterness. How do we rid ourselves of the poison of bitterness? The answer lies there in verse 32, forgiving one another as Christ has forgiven us. When we forgive, we release the person from our personal desire for revenge. We in a sense are turning them over to God, that He may bring justice upon them, or if they repent show them mercy.

Now the mistake we make, which will often keep us from forgiving a wrongdoer is the idea that if we forgive them, we must therefore be fully reconciled to them. But we know that is not true from the words Jesus Himself uttered from the cross. Do you remember how He forgave those who crucified him that day? He said, "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do." So all those that murdered Jesus were forgiven, yet did that meant Jesus was reconciled to them? No. Other than the Centurion in charge of the crucifixion, we don't know of any of the rest who came to Christ begging forgiveness having repented of their participation in the greatest crime ever committed. So when they died, what happened to those unreconciled to Jesus?

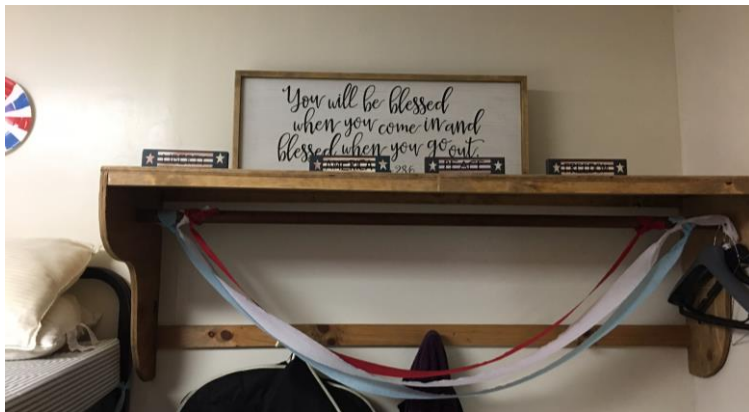

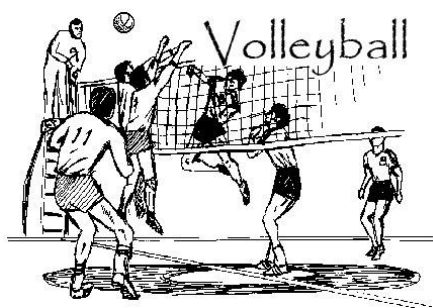
Tuesday's Campfire

How can we forgive? Jesus teaches us by the parable of the unjust steward who would not forgive his fellow, that we can best forgive when we recall how much God has forgiven us, how large and un-payable our debt to Him was and how He forgave us completely. When we see how much God has done for us, then we can generously forgive others and prevent any root of bitterness springing up within our soul. ★
