Tempus fugit: Welcome to our 15th annual family camp.

It is hard to believe that we are holding our 15th annual family camp. Our first camp, held in 2009 at the Toah-Nipi Retreat Center in Rindge, NH, drew about sixty people. Since then, we have more than doubled our annual attendance. Throughout the rest of the year we now hold a weekend family retreat, a lady's retreat, host dozens of speaking engagements, and are invited to speak to groups from Florida to Maine.

In 2010, we started a publishing arm. In 2015, thanks to the efforts of Mr. Affleck and our webmaster Eric Conover, we created the Sam Blumenfeld Archives, the works of our late instructor and a modern pioneer in the home school movement. Hundreds of thousands of people from around the U.S. and the world download the vital works of Mr. Blumenfeld. We recently learned that a school in Zimbabwe will be named in his honor. In 2016, we started a radio show which is now on over a dozen platforms including Amazon and Spotify. In 2020, we became trustees of a house in Lexington, MA-a few blocks from the site of the Battle of Lexington. From this library and learning center we host monthly events. It has become the home of our beloved Chaplain Rev Steve Craft, and Mrs. Edith Craft, our Junior Camp Director.

Last year, we were handed a 9-0 U.S. Supreme Court victory "Shurtleff v Boston" which gained national and international attention. It was a victory for free speech and religious liberty. When a reporter asked me what was next for Camp Constitution after the Supreme Court victory, I said "As the Lord leads".

Thank you all from the bottom of my heart for your dedication and support. You make Camp Constitution possible. Welcome to all our first time attendees. I hope that this week will be a blessing to you and a memorable experience. ★

### Mr. Alex Newman



Traditionally, the campers who most creatively capture the spirit of our camp through theme based decorations, tasteful humor, and patriotism score **big** in the contest. Make it fun! **Hint:** The inspectors are not above the occasional bribery attempt. Points from 0-10 are awarded each day for your participation in this contest. At the end of the week the cabin with the most points will get "**FREE PIZZA**" during the pizza party.

#### **Newspaper Participation**

The newspaper is looking for lecture reviews, free-time fun stories, campfire tidbits, lake-front occurrences etc. Who, what, where, how, why and when are the concepts to keep in mind as you write your stories. The newspaper always needs details on the following recurring events: Flag participants including Scripture reading and grace before meals. Also, don't forget polar bear and morning run as well as campfire participants. We also want to see direct quotes from our speakers.

Your cabin will earn 0-2.5 points each day for your submissions during the week. Your participation will require submissions from multiple campers on multiple topics. Quality, quantity, number of submitters and diversity of topics are the four criterion on which your bonus will be awarded each day. If multiple cabins cover the same topics, the Editor of the newspaper may combine the stories and weave the details but credit will be awarded whether the story is used or not. The bonus is 20% of your total points. Make sure all newspaper submissions have your name and cabin number on them so your team gets credit for the contribution. The bonus will be a running total updated daily and disclosed at the end of the week.

Born in Malaysia, Dr. Soon immigrated to the US in 1980. In 2004, he received the Petr Beckmann Award for outstanding contributions to the defense of scientific truth. ★




