Mr. Alex Newman



Julie Wilkinson, age 64 married 35 years to Bill, parents of three married daughters and grandparents to four. Graduated as an R.N. in 1981. Raised in an intact but quite liberal home. In 1983 after breaking up with a boyfriend, moved to Boulder, CO where a nursing school classmate and friend lived. Accepted a position as abortion assistant at a late term abortion clinic, run by Warren Hern MD. Left after about 2 years there. Experienced a heart change by the grace of God, and partly due to employment in an NICU in Denver. Married in 1987 and moved to Cheyenne. Did not share with friends my dark secret of working in the abortion industry for many years. Moved to Oklahoma in 1996. Eventually made contact with a woman who had herself managed an abortion clinnic, but left the business and went on to creat outreach for abortion clinic workers.. Her name is Anbby Johnson. I gained courage to share my sad story, in the hope it might help women rethink their plans to end their childrens' lives. Today I try to share my story with anyone that is interested. Had a small role in the movie "UNPLANNED" (which was filmed in Oklahoma). It is Abby Johnson's story of redemption.

My prayer is that my story may convince others that ending innocent children's lives is never the answer. *

Traditionally, the campers who most creatively capture the spirit of our camp through theme based decorations, tasteful humor, and patriotism score big in the contest. Make it fun! Hint: The inspectors are not above the occasional bribery attempt. © Points from 0-10 are awarded each day for your participation in this contest. At the end of the week the cabin with the most points will get "FREE PIZZA" during the pizza party.

Newspaper Participation

The newspaper is looking for lecture reviews, free-time fun stories, campfire tidbits, lake-front occurrences etc. Who, what, where, how, why and when are the concepts to keep in mind as you write your stories. The newspaper always needs details on the following recurring events: Flag participants including Scripture reading and grace before meals. Also, don't forget polar bear, morning run, and campfire participants. We also want to see direct quotes from our speakers. Your team should have at least one per day.

Your cabin will earn 0-2.5 points each day for your submissions during the week. Your participation will require submissions from multiple campers on multiple topics. Quality, quantity, number of submitters and diversity of topics are the four criterion on which your bonus will be awarded each day. If multiple cabins cover the same topics, the Editor of the newspaper may combine the stories and weave the details but credit will be awarded whether the story is used or not. The bonus is 20% of your total points. Make sure all newspaper submissions have your name and cabin number on them so your team gets credit for the contribution. The bonus will be a running total updated daily and disclosed at the end of the week.

The newspaper bonus is often a difference maker.




Charmaine Rondon


