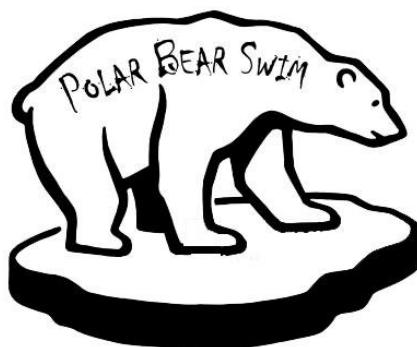
## The Civic Savvy Patriot Report

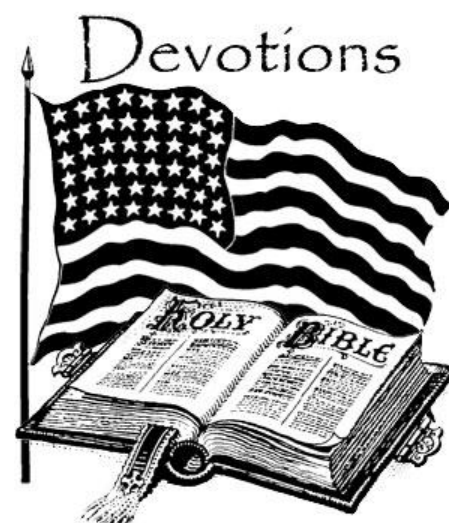

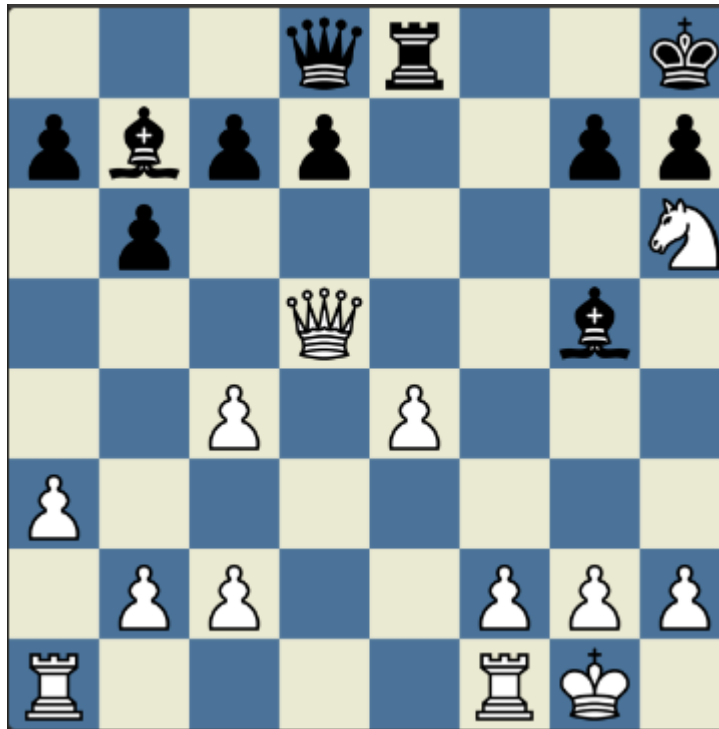

Little by little, he rewrites the image of God within us—using silence, science, and seduction to make his agenda seem like progress. The goal of all this technology is the ultimate ability to be able to control people's behavior and to alter their thinking, updated these instantaneously with a star link capability such that there will be no where to escape.

This technology today operates under the banner of "peace"—smart cities, public health, digital safety—but behind it lies an engine of craft: deception, manipulation, and silent war. We saw it during the global lockdowns, when the WHO claimed to act in our best interest —"for our health," "for our safety"—while governments quietly rolled out 5G towers, biometric checkpoints, and digital surveillance grids. People lined up willingly, even eagerly, for a so-called vaccine that turned out to be a bioweapon—laced with graphene oxide, hydrogel, and lipid nanoparticles.
