

At the end of the week the cabin with the most points will get "FREE PIZZA" during the pizza party.

Newspaper Participation

The newspaper is looking for lecture reviews, free-time fun stories, campfire tidbits, lake-front occurrences etc. Who, what, where, how, why and when are the concepts to keep in mind as you write your stories. 


Dr. Punyamurtula S. Kishore

Dr. Punyamurtula S. Kishore is the founder of Preventive Medicine Associates, Addiction Medicine Associates, and National Library of Addiction and has been a practicing public health scientist for over 30 years. He began his medical career as a primary care / family practice physician and then moved into a position as the Medical Director of the Washingtonian Center for Addictions, the first organization in the U.S. to recognize addiction as a disease.

Their philosophy was an early precursor to the AA or 12-step program. Kishore has been a member of the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) since 1986 and has helped treat more than 200,000 addicts. In 2010 Dr. Kishore earned the Prestigious Distinction as a Distinguished Fellow of the American Society of Addiction Medicine, a title that is only granted every other year to select ASAM physician members for their significant contributions to the Society and to the field of addiction medicine.

Dr. Kishore treats addicts with his 'sobriety maintenance' method. This unique health model stresses the prescription of non-toxic substances and provision of coping skills patients need to remain sober.




Kishore also administers "de-addiction" treatment, a process that treats emotional addiction as well as the physical addiction. Patients have access to home detoxification, an inexpensive and more effective option to in-patient care which allows them to maintain their dignity while learning how to cope with the temptations found in their own environments.

In 1993, Kishore founded National Library of Addictions to support work in addictions treatment. It is designed to provide a non-profit

structure for addiction professionals to exchanges ideas and further the development of treatment methodologies.

Dr. Kishore was honored by the Boston Celtics with a "Heroes Among Us" award, given to those who make a significant impact on the lives of others. Kishore is also the recipient of a national Compassionate Caregiver Award, Honorable Mention, from the Schwartz Foundation.

Kishore served as a faculty member of Harvard and as an Assistant Professor of Medicine at the University of Massachusetts. Currently, he serves as the Assistant Professor of Business Administration at Fitchburg State University. He holds his Master's Degree in Public Health from Harvard School of Public Health, in addition to Certificates in Forensic Psychology from Bridgewater State University. Dr. Kishore currently serves as the Minister of Health and Healing for various organizations.*

THE ★ LEE ★ RESOLUTION

July 2, 1776 — It might surprise you to know that July 2nd was the actual day of Independence for the Colonists in America.

John Adams wrote his wife Abigail on July 3 about the resolution of independence:

The second day of July, 1776, will be the most memorable epoch in the history of America. I am apt to believe that it will be celebrated by succeeding generations as the great anniversary festival. It ought to be commemorated as the day of deliverance, by solemn acts of devotion to God Almighty. It ought to be solemnized with pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires, and illuminations, from one end of this continent to the other, from this time forward forever more.

Adams' prediction was off by two days. From the outset, Americans celebrated Independence Day on July 4, the date the much-publicized Declaration of Independence was approved, rather than on July 2, the date the resolution of independence was adopted.

In honor of the events of July 2nd some two hundred and forty-one years ago today, it is fitting that we review the events leading to the resolution and the declaration. It was, in fact, the resolution of Congress on July 2 that had the force of law. No doubt, the declaration was the instrument whereby the peoples of the world were informed of the plight of the colonists. The reasons for separation helped to garner support and recognition of the resolution. Its importance cannot be understated; however, its existence was reliant on the passage of Lee's Resolution. Without the force of law, the declaration would have never seen the light of day.



The Lee Resolution

When the American Revolutionary War began in 1775, few colonists in British North America openly advocated independence from Great Britain. The majority of colonist sought reconciliation with the British Empire.

Support for independence began to grow especially after the publication of Thomas

steadily in 1776, especially after the publication of Thomas Paine's pamphlet Common Sense in January of that year.

In the Second Continental Congress, the movement towards independence was guided principally by an informal alliance of delegates eventually known as the "Adams-Lee Junto", named after Samuel Adams and John Adams of Massachusetts and Richard Henry Lee of Virginia.

On May 15, 1776, the Fifth Virginia Convention, then meeting

in Williamsburg, passed a resolution instructing Virginia's delegates in the Continental Congress "to propose to that respectable body to declare the United Colonies free and independent States, absolved from all allegiance to, or dependence upon, the Crown or Parliament of Great Britain". In accordance with those instructions, on June 7, Richard Henry Lee proposed the resolution to Congress and it was seconded by John Adams.

Resolved, That these United Colonies are, and of right ought to be, free and independent States, that they are absolved from all allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain is, and ought to be, totally dissolved.

That it is expedient forthwith to take the most effectual measures for forming foreign Alliances.

That a plan of confederation be prepared and transmitted to the respective Colonies for their consideration and approbation.

Congress as a whole was not yet ready to declare independence at that moment, because the delegates from some of the colonies, including Maryland, Pennsylvania, Delaware, New Jersey, and New York, had not yet been authorized to vote for independence. Voting on the first clause of Lee's Resolution was therefore postponed for three weeks while advocates of independence worked to build support in the colonial governments for the resolution. Meanwhile, a Committee of Five was appointed to prepare a formal declaration so that it would be ready when independence, which almost everyone recognized was now inevitable, was approved. The committee prepared a declaration of independence, written primarily by Thomas Jefferson, and presented it to Congress on June 28, 1776.

The vote on the independence section of the Lee Resolution had been postponed until Monday, July 1st, when it was taken up by the Committee of the Whole. At the request of South Carolina, the resolution was not acted upon until the following day in the hope of securing unanimity. A trial vote had been tested on the 1st where it was found that South Carolina and Pennsylvania were in the negative, with Delaware split in a tie between its two delegates. The vote was held on July 2nd, with critical changes happening between Monday and Tuesday. Edward Rutledge was able to persuade South Carolina delegates to vote yea; two Pennsylvania delegates were persuaded to be absent; and Caesar Rodney had been sent for during the night to break Delaware's tie. So Lee's Resolution of independence was approved by twelve of the thirteen colonies. Delegates from New York still lacked instructions to vote for independence, and so they abstained on this vote, although on July 9 the New York Provincial Congress would vote to "join with the other colonies in supporting" independence.★ --- Mark Affleck
