Award nominations:

For the first time in history, Western Intercollegiate Football League nominees were shut out in the voting for national awards.

The West's representatives on the Canadian Interuniversity Athletic Union ballot were:

HEC CRIGHTON (outstanding player): Duane Hysop, quarterback, University of Manitoba.

J.P. METRAS (outstanding lineman): Scott MacArthur, defensive end, University of Calgary.

PETER GORMAN (Rookie-of-the-Year): Ben Der, guard, University of Alberta.

In voting by WIFL coaches to determine the league's nominee, Hysop out-pollled, listed alphabetically: Forrest Kennerd, Alberta; Kevin Konar, University of British Columbia; Darcy Krogh, Calgary and Gene Wall, University of Saskatchewan.

MacArthur got the nod over Rob Bunce, Saskatchewan; Ken Moore, Alberta; George Seidel, Manitoba and Mark Wald, British Columbia.

Der, meanwhile, received the nomination on a ballot that included Mike Emery, British Columbia; Dave Loewen, Manitoba; Scott Redl, Saskatchewan and Greg Vavra, Calgary.

It was the first time since the introduction of the three-award format that the West was totally zeroed.

Darcy Krogh of the University of Calgary and University of Manitoba's Barry Safiniuk screeched their tires this autumn along the streets of the Western Intercollegiate Football League.

The neighbors didn't complain . . . but, the defences were ready to telephone the police!

Krogh, who had caught only one pass in 1978, had 40 receptions for the Dinosaurs. That statistic not only led the West, but it was the best in the country!

Safiniuk, meanwhile, didn't score a point, much less a touchdown, in '78. But, he got into the end zone on a dozen occasions this season — an achievement that also led the nation!

It goes, almost without saying, that the Bisons' running back thus topped the scoring parade in both the WIFL and Canadian Interuniversity Athletic Union. With twin two-point converts, he had 76 points.

Two other WIFL players, Les Oakes of Manitoba and Trevor Kennerd of the University of Alberta's champion Golden Bears, were involved in a tie for second (66) in both the West and the CIAU scene.

Elsewhere, in national individual statistics:

In rushing, University of Saskatchewan Huskies' Gene Wall and Jim Manz were No. 2 and No. 4, respectively. Acadia's Henry Sereault led the country with 710 yards. Wall had 679 and Manz, 623.

In receiving, behind Krogh, were Safiniuk (second, 39 receptions) and Alberta's Dave Brown (fifth, 29).

Meanwhile, in passing, Golden Bears' Forrest Kennerd was second — 1,621 yards to the 1,821 total of Windsor's Scott Mallender. Duane Hysop of Manitoba was fourth (1,372) and University of British Columbia Thunderbirds' Greg Clarkson, fifth (1,213).

Kevin Konar of British Columbia and Saskatchewan's Paul Hickie were among those tied for sixth in punting (39.8), a category won by Neil Ellison of St. Mary's (43.3).

In punt returns, Calgary's Jamie Armstead had 515 yards, second only to Jed Palmaci of Acadia (546). Alberta's Kerry O'Connor was No. 4 (350).

Bill Hasiuk of Manitoba finished second in the other specialty, kickoff returns. He had 344 yards and the national leader was McMaster's Carlyle Buchanan (445). Jack Hirose of British Columbia and Calgary's Tim Petros tied for sixth (240).

Seven interceptions by Huskies' Murray Sadownick gave him No. 2 status in the country, behind Kevin Aver of St. Francis X. Gord Syme of Alberta and Hirose were in a traffic jam for fifth, each with five thefts.

All-star teams:

University of British Columbia linebacker Kevin Konar was a repeater as an all-Canadian in 1979.

He was named to the team, announced by the Canadian Interuniversity Athletic Union, with five other players from the Western Intercollegiate Football League — three off the campus of the University of Calgary.

Dinosaurs making it were wide receiver Darcy Krogh, offensive tackle Tom Trifaux and defensive end Scott MacArthur.

Also taking a bow during College Bowl Week, in Toronto, were offensive tackle George Seidel, University of Manitoba and British Columbia deep back Jack Hirose.

Meanwhile, at the league level, University of Saskatchewan dominated the all-star team. The Huskies, who finished in the cellar, climbed to the penthouse in voting by league coaches, placing eight players on the all-star roster.

Thunderbirds had seven players on the team; Manitoba, six; Calgary, four and University of Alberta Golden Bears, three.

With ties (tight end and deep back) and including, for the first time, a punter and a place-kicker, the all-star lineup totalled 28.

The repeaters, from '78, were: British Columbia's Konar, Mark Wald and Chris Davies, a tight end the previous autumn and Gene Wall and Rob Bunce, Saskatchewan.

Coach-of-the-Year was Manitoba's Dennis Hrycaiko.
