Exterior features include 1/1 double-hung sash with molded cornice and plain surrounds; multi-pane fixed sash; 2-story bay window on east facade with bracketed cornices; plain cornice; decorative frieze board; corner boards; hip roof wrap-around porch with carved brackets and chamfered posts; wood panel front door with transom. Notable landscape features include 1 wood frame, gable roof outbuilding and 1 concrete block outbuilding.			
This house was constructed in 1889 for Reverend Lindsey, pastor of the Congregational Church and first principal of the Puget Sound Academy. The structure remains a private residence with an upstairs apartment. Few changes have been made to the exterior of the structure. 1995: The outbuildings were removed; one contributing building
