The house was sold to Will Jenne in 1908. The house remained in the Jenne family until it was sold to Mattie and Ivar Powell in 1950. The house was sold again in 1967 and since then has had several owners. Few changes have been made to the exterior and interior of the structure although asbestos shingle covers the original siding and the back porch has been
