Exterior features include 1/1 double-hung sash; 2/2 double-hung sash; 2-story bay window on east facade; recessed panels with diagonal and vertical stickwork; 1/1 double-hung sash; pedimented portico on east facade with sunburst design, chamfered posts, quatrefoil screen, cut curved brackets with fan motif: 3-panelled door with plain entablature and molded cornice; corner boards; plain frieze board. A.B. Coates, owner of Whidbey Merchantile Co., built this house with the aid of his two sons in 1892. Several additions have been made to the structure over the years. The structure is currently vacant but was recently sold to an individual with plans for restoring it. 1995: One contributing building.
