In 1897, Charles Terry purchased the site of the Coupeville Mill Company and erected a building to house a fruit dryer. The business processed locally grown fruits and vegetables for shipment to the Alaskan gold fields. James Gillespie purchased the building in 1908 for use as a livery and feed stable. During the 1950's, Lindsay's Marina occupied the building. It currently contains an antique store and ice cream parlor. 1995: Two large storefront windows added on south facade.
