Queen Anne Residence. Wood frame set on post and block foundation; L-shape (26' x 20') with 1-story addition on south facade; 2 bays wide; 1½-stories; shiplap siding with diamond-cut shingles on gable ends; steeply-pitched, wood-shingled gable roof with clipped cross gable on west facade; off-center entrance on north facade; corbelled center chimney. Exterior features include 1/1 double-hung sash with molded cornice and surround; 1-story, 3-sided bay window on north facade with 2/2 double-hung sash, decorative railing on roof, paired carved brackets and wood panels; 1-story, 3-sided bay window on east facade with 1/1 double-hung sash and stained glass panes, mansard roof with bracketed cornice, and decorative clipped corners with pendants over side windows; plain cornice; decorative frieze board; narrow, gable-roofed dormer on north facade; hip-roofed, wrap-around porch on north facade with carved brackets and chamfered posts; wood panel door with transom; lattice skirting. Notable landscape features include 1 wood frame, gable-roofed outbuilding.

1995: One contributing building; one non-contributing structure.


Captain Clapp, a sea captain and local public official, purchased this house in 1886. The Clapp's resided in the house for over 50 years. In the 1920's, they added the 1-story bedroom on the west facade. A retired navy family purchased the house in the mid-1940's. The next owners were Ronald and Mable Race who bought the house in the late 1950's. The Mosher's owned the house during the 1960's and made many changes to the interior. Ron VanDyk purchased the house in 1969 and has been restoring the interior. He added the bay window on the east facade which was salvaged from the Kohne House at Prairie Center.

It retains integrity of location, setting, materials, design, workmanship, feeling and association.
