Vernacular Farm Building. Wood frame set on post and block foundation; rectangle (12' x 14') with shed roof addition on north facade; 1 1/2-stories; board and batten siding; wood-shingled gable roof with extended eaves and exposed rafter ends; off-set panelled double door entrance on south facade.

This structure was built c.1905 as a farm building. During the 1950's, the structure served as the Printing Office of the Coupeville Courier Newspaper. It is currently used as a storage shed.

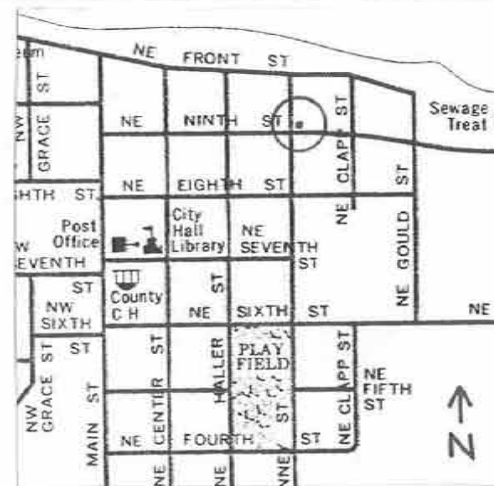
