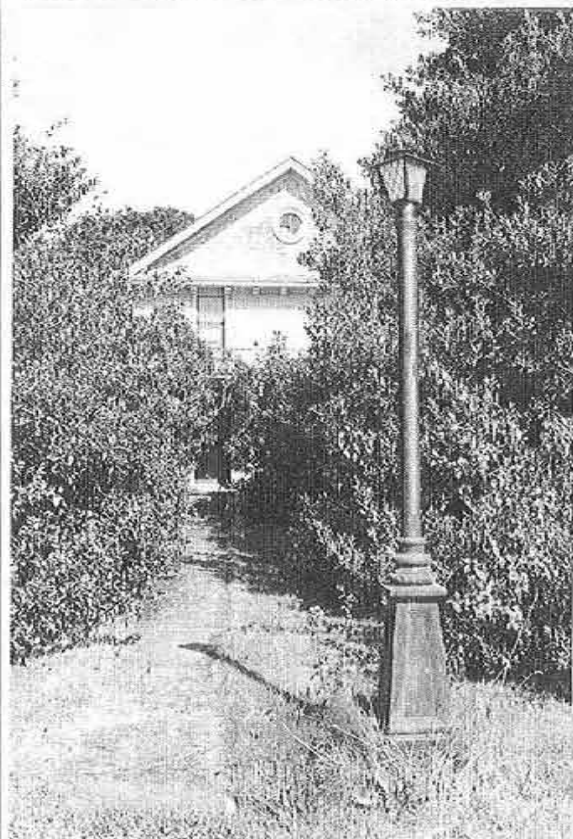

DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND HISTORY INCLUDING CONSTRUCTION DATE(S), PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS, MATERIALS, MAJOR ALTERATIONS, IMPORTANT BUILDERS, ARCHITECTS, ENGINEERS, ETC. Queen Anne Farmhouse with classical elements. Wood frame set on timber/stone foundation; irregular (44'x57') with multiple additions; 5 bays wide; 2½-stories; clapboard siding with wood-shingled upper gables on east, west facades; off-center entrance with panelled door and molded cornice on west facade; corbelled exterior end chimney on east facade. Exterior features include 1/1 double-hung sash; lozenge-shaped leaded glass sash; round, ¼-pane sash in pedimented west gable; molded boxed cornice; cornice returns on east facade; 2-story polygonal tower on south-west corner with 1/1 double-hung sash and 2nd story panelled door; 1-story porch with shingled rail, supported by Tuscan columns, with balustrade above, on west facade; modillioned cornice on west facade; gable-roofed polygonal extension on north facade with 1/1 double-hung sash, decorative clipped corners and vergeboard; hip-roofed section on south-east facade with shed-roofed, wrap-around porch supported by Tuscan columns. SIGNIFICANCE This property is significant under National Register criterion A, for its association with early Euroamerican settlement in the Pacific Northwest and the Donation Land Claim Laws, in the period between 1850 and 1870. This property is also significant under National Register criterion A, for its association with agricultural land use patterns first established during the period of early settlement in the 1850s. It retains integrity of location, setting, materials, design, workmanship, feeling and association.

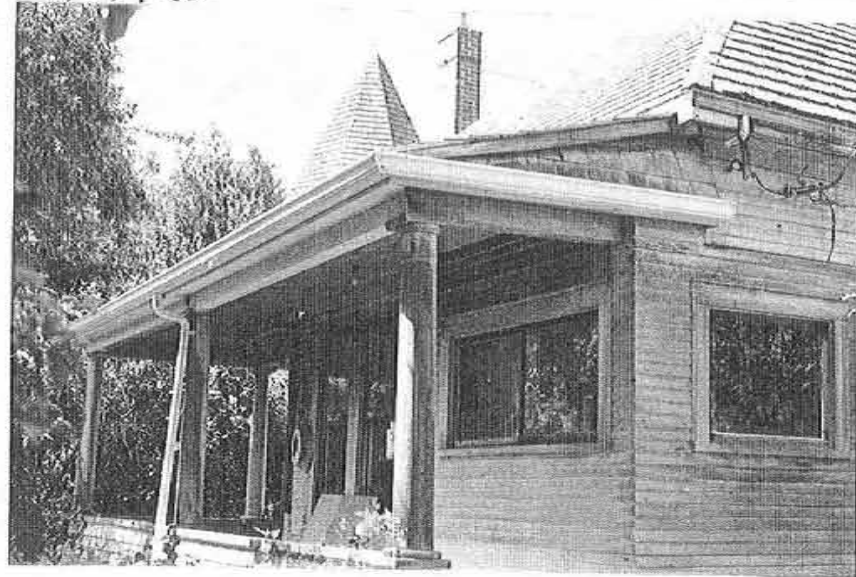
