Exterior features include 1/1, 2/2 double-hung sash; boxed cornice; plain frieze board; corner boards; shed-roofed porch with chamfered posts. Notable landscape features include 1 wood frame gambrel-roofed barn with multi-pane fixed sash and corner boards; 1 wood frame gable-roofed outbuilding. This farmhouse was built for the Anderson's by carpenter John Jofferson. Jofferson also built the large barn on the property. The Andersons lived here until the late 1960's.
