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Military Building. Wood frame set on post and block foundation; rectangle (8' x 18'); 3 bays wide; 1-story; shiplap siding; asphalt-shingled gable roof; off-center entrance on south facade. Exterior features include 6-pane fixed sash with molded sill; exposed rafter ends; corner boards; single panelled door.

The Fort Casey Military Reservation included numerous service buildings such as this 1906 water pump house. It is now owned by the City of Coupeville and continues to be used as a pump house.
