COP 15 PARALLEL EVENT Ecological Civilization Forum

1. Concept note

Biodiversity conservation is a critical goal in the development of an ecological civilization. In line with the theme of COP 15: "Ecological Civilization: Building a Shared Future for All Life on Earth", the objective of this forum is to provide a platform for representatives from all walks of life to: 1) to share experiences and achievements in global biodiversity conservation, improvement of people's livelihood and well-being and green development, 2) to gather consensus on ecological civilization, 3) to promote exchanges and cooperation in global biodiversity conservation and ecological civilization-related fields, and provide experience and wisdom for building a global community of life and achieving harmonious coexistence between human beings and nature. In accordance with the theme of COP15 and in line with the objectives of this forum, the theme of the Ecological Civilization Forum is: working together to build a harmonious and beautiful world for all life on the planet.

2. Programme outline

The proposed forum would consist of 3 parts: an opening ceremony of the plenary meeting, 7 theme sub-forums, and a closing ceremony. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, this forum is planned to be held both online and in person. Representatives abroad and some domestic participants may attend this forum via Interactio with Chinese and English simultaneous interpretation (link to be provided on the CBD website before the meeting). The forum will also be live-streamed online via YouTube.

It's proposed to invite heads of international organizations, leaders of ministries and local governments to deliver opening remarks, and invite and award medals to representatives of the 5th batch of "national development of an ecological civilization" demonstration cities and counties and "lucid waters and

lush mountains are invaluable assets" innovation bases, as well as national and international well-known experts and scholars, and representatives from international organizations, local governments to give keynote speeches. Also, participants will sign a "Building a Shared Community of Life on Earth and Protecting Global Biodiversity" initiative during closing ceremony of the forum.

There will be 7 sub-forums planned in line with the overall theme of the forum. They will focus on significant international issues, key regions and key fields, starting from the requirements developing an ecological civilization and aiming at promoting regional and global biodiversity conservation. List is as follows:

Sub forum 1, Towards a Carbon Neutral Future: Synergy between Climate Change and Biodiversity;

Sub forum 2, Mainstreaming Ecological Civilization and Biodiversity Conservation;

Sub forum 3, "Lucid Waters and Lush Mountains are Invaluable Assets"-From Theory to Practice;

Sub forum 4, Nature-based Solutions for Ecological Conservation and Restoration;

Sub forum 5, Natural Capital Accounting and Ecological Product Value-Realization;

Sub forum 6, Ecological Civilization and Ecological Security of the Tibetan Plateau:

Sub forum 7, Financial Sector Supporting Biodiversity.

3. Expected Outcomes

- 3.1. Launch of the "Building a Shared Community of Life on Earth and Protecting Global Biodiversity" Initiative.
- 3.2. The thematic sub-forums will lead to the publication of research reports, case studies and other relevant achievements to show global efforts and

accomplishments in biodiversity conservation, promoting ecological civilization, and global sustainable development.

3.3. Preparation of a compilation of forum research and discussion results to provide references, suggestions, cases, methods and actions for the COP15 conference and post-2020 biodiversity conservation.
