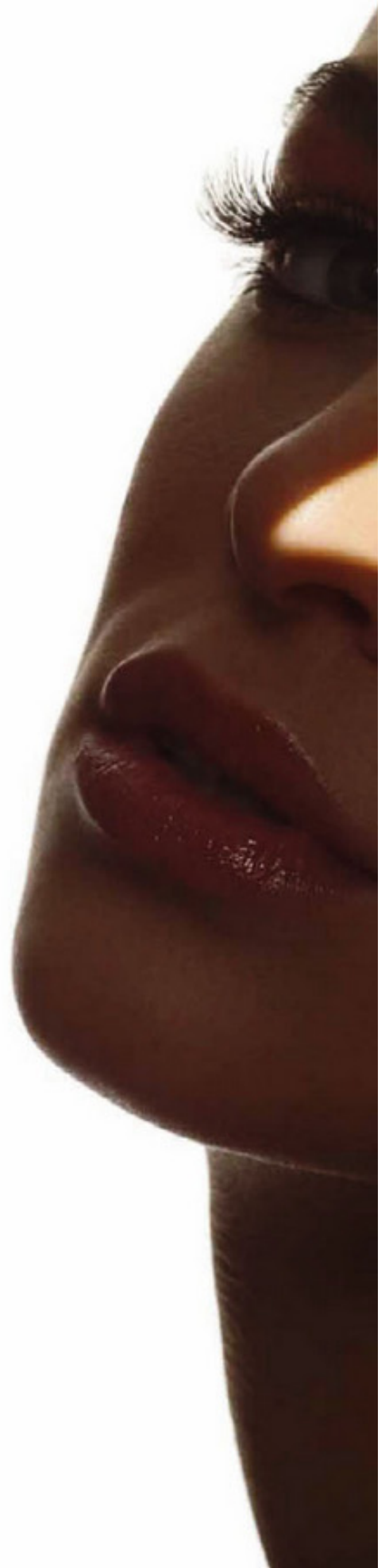

SEVERAL BRANDS of over-the-counter lash “conditioners” once contained the same active ingredient as Latisse, so they literally made lashes grow. They were banned by the FDA in 2007, however, since it is illegal for a cosmetic to contain an ingredient classified as a drug. Yet products persist that promise to make lashes grow longer and thicker. In fact, [Sephora](#) sells a wide selection, and [Drugstore.com](#) recently added a “Lash Growth & Conditioners” category to its website.
