STATE OF THE ART ASTHMA & ALLERGY CLINIC ANNOUNCES GRAND OPENING

The Vancouver, Washington area will be the home of a new state of the art asthma and allergy clinic. The Columbia Asthma & Allergy Clinic announced today that the opening of their new asthma and allergy medical facility will be Friday, November 18, 2005.

The clinic is the vision of Medical Director, Sanjeev Jain. Dr. Jain, a long respected leader in the asthma and allergy field, saw a need for a one stop facility for asthma and allergy patients. In addition to being a working clinic the facility will have extended stay capabilities and a state-of-the-art clinical laboratory with 24-hour turn-around on laboratory and other immunology testing. The clinic will also have necessary supplies and hypoallergenic products available for patients.

The clinic is located in Camas at 3400 SE 196th Ave., near QFC in The Glen business development. The facility was designed with the patient in mind providing a comfortable, warm feeling. Designers used generous layers of texture and many spectacular features such a rich pallet of modern paint colors, hand crafted wood work, travertine tile and brilliant stone floors. "We really wanted the overall look and feel of the clinic to reflect the homes in the neighborhood. When you can make visiting the doctor feel like being at home you have put the patient at ease before they arrive and that is always a good thing," noted Dr. Jain.

Dr. Jain, earned joint M.D. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Wisconsin and residency training in internal medicine from the University of Texas. Jain went on to obtain a three-year fellowship training in allergy and immunology from Yale University School of Medicine.

“I chose the Camas area because my family fell in love with the area. I wanted to be part of a growing community, offering high quality, personalized care for allergy patients,” explained Dr. Jain.

Before moving to Vancouver, Dr. Jain was part of the faculty at the University Of Washington School Of Medicine in Seattle Washington. Dr. Jain’s wife is a radiologist at Southwest Washington Medical Center.
