PMG Grading Tiers & Services, Effective January 1, 2021

(Turnaround times are approximate and not guaranteed. Estimated turnaround begins on the day notes are received by PMG.)

A \$10 handling fee per invoice applies to all submissions.



PMG GRADING TIERS	FEE (per note)	ESTIMATED TURNAROUND	REQUIREMENTS
US and World Notes An attribution fee of \$5 per note is charged when notes submitted are not accompanied by a proper catalog number. (e.g. Friedberg, Pick, etc.)			
Unlimited WalkThrough	\$250 + 1% FMV	24 business hours	Notes valued \$25,001 and up.
WalkThrough	\$225	24 business hours	Notes valued up to \$25,000.
Express	\$100	5 working days	Notes valued up to \$10,000.
Standard	\$50	14 working days	Notes valued up to \$3,000.
Economy	\$30	28 working days	Notes valued up to \$1,000 excluding errors, test notes, specimens, proofs, essays, contemporary counterfeits and / or notes NOT listed in Friedberg, Haxby, Criswell, Schwan, Charlton or the <i>Standard Catalog of World Paper Money</i> . Submit these notes under the Economy Special tier.
Economy Special	\$40	28 working days	Notes valued up to \$1,000. Use the Economy Special tier (or a higher tier) for all errors, test notes, specimens, proofs, essays, contemporary counterfeits and / or notes NOT listed in Friedberg, Haxby, Criswell, Schwan, Charlton or the <i>Standard Catalog of World Paper Money</i> . Scrip notes may be submitted under the Economy tier, even if they are not listed in one of these references. Note: PMG will not adjust the grading tier or give a refund if PMG determines that the note is not an error, test note, specimen, proof, essay or contemporary counterfeit.
Modern (1957–Present)	\$20	28 working days	Notes valued up to \$300. All notes issued 1957 to present except error notes, test notes, specimens and proofs.
Bulk Submission		Varies	Applies to all bulk submissions: Notes valued up to \$300. 50-note minimum. The following notes are NOT eligible for bulk submission tiers: error notes, test notes, specimens, proofs and Chinese notes issued from 1948 through the 1953 First Series notes (Pick numbers 800 to 859).
Consecutive Notes	\$13		Consecutive Notes: All notes must be the same catalog number and all serial numbers must be in consecutive order. All vintage or modern notes are accepted provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
Mixed Vintage (Pre-1957)	\$20		Mixed Vintage: Notes may be a mix of catalog numbers and / or serial numbers. All notes issued before 1957 are accepted provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
Mixed Modern (1957–Present)	\$16		Mixed Modern: Notes may be a mix of catalog numbers and / or serial numbers. All notes issued 1957 to present are accepted provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
Bond and Stock Certificates			
Economy (ESB)	\$45	15 working days	Bond and stock certificates valued up to \$1,000. Request “ESB” in bold letters on the submission form. See PMGnotes.com/news/article/7703/ for more information. Certificates larger than 400 x 470 mm are encapsulated on a case-by-case basis.
High Value (HSB)	\$75	15 working days	Bond and stock certificates valued over \$1,000. Request “HSB” in bold letters on the submission form. See PMGnotes.com/news/article/7703/ for more information. Certificates larger than 400 x 470 mm are encapsulated on a case-by-case basis.

A \$10 adjustment fee will be charged for submission forms that must be modified prior to processing. This includes forms with more than one tier listed and bumps in tier levels due to undervalued notes.
Note: Please limit notes to 50 per submission form. For bulk submissions, please limit notes to 100 per form. Use multiple submission forms as needed.

The following service options are available for both US and World note submissions.

Early Releases / First Releases	Tier + \$12	According to tier	Use this service to receive either the EARLY RELEASES or FIRST RELEASES designation for qualifying notes. Select only one. Visit PMGnotes.com/cutoffdates for a list of eligible notes and submission cutoff dates.
Special Labels	Tier + \$5	According to tier	Use this service to request a special PMG label. For a list of special PMG labels, visit PMGnotes.com/labels. Request desired label number on the submission form.
PMG Oversize Holder	Tier + \$20	According to tier	Select this service for notes and / or sheets 195 x 120 mm to 205 x 220 mm in size. Must be submitted on a separate form. PMG reserves the right to use a larger holder and charge the submitter the appropriate fees for notes that are close to the maximum dimensions of the requested holder type.
Custom Holder	\$35	According to tier	Select the Custom Holder for notes and / or sheets sized between 205 x 220 mm and 400 x 470 mm. Notes or sheets larger than 400 x 470 mm are encapsulated on a case-by-case basis only.
Variety	Tier + \$8	According to tier	Additional attribution not mentioned in Friedberg, Haxby, Criswell, Schwan, Charlton & the <i>Standard Catalog of World Paper Money</i> , as well as all “f” fluorescence attributions for Chinese RMB notes. The Variety fee applies when requested regardless of whether PMG determines the note to be a recognized variety.
Pedigree	Tier + \$5	According to tier	A pedigree can be added to the certification label to indicate a note’s past or present ownership. The Pedigree service must also be selected for all notes with a courtesy autograph. To pedigree a note to a previous owner, that collector or collection must be considered to be significant by PMG and sufficient documentation (including copies of auction lots and plates, sales invoices or other backup) must be provided to confirm the requested pedigree. You can also pedigree a note to yourself, typically without providing any documentation. To add a pedigree to notes already encapsulated by PMG, also select an applicable PMG ReHolder service. Print clearly on the submission form exactly how you want the pedigree to appear on the PMG label. All pedigrees are subject to PMG’s approval. The Pedigree fee applies when requested regardless of whether PMG determines the note to have an eligible pedigree.
ReGrade	Tier price	According to tier Ex: Regrade Express is 5 working days	If you disagree with a grade assigned by PMG, you may submit the note for review for a higher grade. Note must be intact in its PMG holder. Also choose a grading tier according to note value and desired turnaround time. Grading fees will apply.
CrossOver	Tier	According to tier	Review of PCGS Currency-holdered notes for PMG certification. See PMGnotes.com/news/article/7213/ for complete information.

ReHolder	\$12	5 working days	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes valued up to \$10,000.
High Value ReHolder	\$50	5 working days	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes valued over \$10,000.
Oversize ReHolder	\$20	5 working days	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets 195 x 120 mm to 205 x 220 mm in size. Notes valued up to \$10,000.
High Value Oversize ReHolder	\$75	5 working days	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets 195 x 120 mm to 205 x 220 mm in size.
Custom ReHolder	\$35	5 working days	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets sized between 205 x 220 mm and 400 x 470 mm. Notes valued up to \$10,000.
High Value Custom ReHolder	\$85	5 working days	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets sized between 205 x 220 mm and 400 x 470 mm. Notes valued over \$10,000.

Appearance Review	\$0 per note	12 working days	Review of a PMG note you believe is over graded.
Return Packaging	\$5 per form	Tier + 5 working days	Examples include Certificates of Authenticity, auction tags, and folders / boxes. If sending COAs or auction tags for verification purposes, please send copies. Do not send originals.
Internet Imaging	\$5 per note	Tier + 5 working days	Digital imaging for notes submitted under any of PMG’s grading and service tiers. Consists of accurate high-resolution images of the front and back of the note, shown encapsulated in its PMG holder. Applies to all notes on the form.
