

NGC HONG KONG SERVICES & FEES

Effective September 15, 2020

For submissions to NGC Hong Kong Limited (NGC Hong Kong) only.

US, world and ancient coins must be submitted on separate submission forms.

All fees and maximum values are US dollars.

Fees include round trip shipping and insurance between NGC Hong Kong and NGC Headquarters.

A \$15 handling fee per invoice applies to all submissions.



NGC is the official grading service of the ANA, PNG and the Macau Numismatic Society.

NGC GRADING TIERS	FEE PER COIN (USD)	REQUIREMENTS
Unlimited Value WalkThrough	\$300 + 1% Fair Market Value (FMV)	All coins. Unlimited value. Includes Scratch-Resistant Holder. Ancient coins valued above \$25,000 have an additional fee. Call for details.
WalkThrough	\$125	All coins. Maximum value \$100,000. Includes Scratch-Resistant Holder. Ancient coins valued above \$25,000 have an additional fee. Call for details.
Express	\$65	All coins. Maximum value \$10,000. Includes Scratch-Resistant Holder.
† All tiers above include Scratch-Resistant Holders for no additional fee. †		
† Upgrade to Scratch-Resistant Holders for the following tiers for an additional \$5.00 per coin. †		
Standard	\$45	All coins. Maximum value \$3,000.
Gold	\$30	All common date gold coins. Maximum value \$3,000. No ancient coins.
Economy	\$22	All non-gold coins. Maximum value \$300. Ancient coins submitted under the Economy tier receive a basic description / grade only.
Modern	\$17	All coins 1955 to present (no patterns, die trials, etc.). Maximum value \$2,000.
Modern Bulk (mixed type)	\$16	All coins 1955 to present (no patterns, die trials, etc). Maximum value \$2,000. One hundred (100)-coin minimum. Early Releases / First Releases / Special Label are included with the Modern Bulk grading fee (if applicable).
Modern Bulk (same type)	\$15	All coins 1955 to present (no patterns, die trials, etc.). Coins must be same type. Maximum value \$2,000. One hundred (100)-coin minimum. Early Releases / First Releases / Special Label are included with the Modern Bulk grading fee (if applicable).

Turnaround times vary based on NGC Hong Kong volume. Occasionally there may be a delay on world coins as extra research is required on more esoteric items.

NGC ADD-ON SERVICES	FEE PER COIN (USD)	DESCRIPTION
Early Releases / First Releases	Tier fee + \$5	Use this service to receive either the EARLY RELEASES or FIRST RELEASES designation for qualifying coins. Select only one. Visit NGCcoin.hk/cutoffdates for a list of eligible coins and submission cutoff dates.
Special Label	Tier fee + \$5	Use this service to request a special NGC label. For a list of special NGC labels, visit NGCcoin.hk/labels. Note: If you would like to have different special labels for the coins listed on the form, write "MIXED" on the Special Label line in Section 11 and list the desired Special Label Name and # on each line next to the coin in Section 15.
VarietyPlus	Tier fee + \$15	Upon request, NGC examines coins for recognized varieties and certifies with applicable designation. Choose a grading tier according to coin value. See NGCcoin.hk/varietyplus for a complete list of varieties we recognize. If you would like a coin already graded by NGC reviewed for variety, do not select a grading tier. Select VarietyPlus service option. The VarietyPlus fee applies when requested regardless of whether NGC determines the coin to be a recognized variety.
Mint Error	Tier fee + \$15	NGC examines Mint Errors and assigns a designation. Coins will be encapsulated at NGC's discretion. Also, choose a grading tier according to coin value and desired turnaround. The Mint Error fee applies when requested regardless of whether NGC determines the coin to be a recognized mint error.
NGC Oversize Holder	Tier fee + \$15	Coins over 45 mm in diameter are placed in an NGC Oversize Holder. Must be submitted on a separate submission form.
NGC Double Thick Holder	Tier fee + \$5	Coins 4.5 to 9 mm thick (and have a diameter of 45 mm or less) are placed in a Double Thick Holder. Must be submitted on a separate submission form.
NGC Mega Holder	Tier fee + \$150	Coins as large as 180 mm in diameter and 28 mm in thickness are encapsulated in the NGC Mega Holder. Contact Customer Service to confirm eligibility.
Pedigree	Tier fee	For public collections, submit copies of auction lots and plates, sales invoices or other backup of pedigree.
ReGrade	Tier fee	If you disagree with a grade assigned by NGC, you may submit the coin for review for a higher grade. Coin must be intact in its holder. Also, choose a grading tier according to coin value.
CrossOver	Tier fee	Review of PCGS-holdered coins for NGC certification. Coins will be removed from their holders and encapsulated by NGC only if NGC determines that the coins will receive an NGC grade that is the same grade or higher than the grade assigned by PCGS. If you would like your PCGS-holdered coin certified by NGC even if NGC determines that it will receive a lower numeric grade, specify ANY in the CrossOver Minimum Grade column of the NGC Submission Form. If you would like your PCGS-holdered coin certified by NGC even if NGC determines that it will receive an NGC Details grade (or a lower numeric grade), specify DETAILS in the CrossOver Minimum Grade column of the NGC Submission Form. You may not request a minimum grade that is higher than the grade that is on the PCGS holder. Coins holdered by other grading services are not eligible for CrossOver and must be removed from their holders and submitted raw (not holdered), or they may be submitted in their holders if they are accompanied by NGC's Consent to Remove Coin(s) from Holder(s) Form.

REHOLDERS	FEE PER COIN (USD)	DESCRIPTION
ReHolder	\$10	A coin in an NGC holder can be submitted for placement in a new holder. Maximum value \$10,000. Note: Submit Double Thick Holders for ReHolder under either ReHolder or High Value ReHolder, as applicable.
High Value ReHolder	\$30	A coin in an NGC holder is placed in a new holder. Unlimited value.
Oversize ReHolder	\$15	A coin in an NGC Oversize Holder (coins over 45 mm) is placed in a new holder. Maximum value \$10,000.
High Value Oversize ReHolder	\$55	A coin in an NGC Oversize Holder (coins over 45 mm) is placed in a new holder. Unlimited value.
NGC Mega ReHolder	\$200	A coin in an NGC Mega Holder is placed in a new holder. Unlimited value.

OTHER SERVICES	FEE (USD)	DESCRIPTION
Designation Review	\$12 per coin	NGC-certified coins you'd like reviewed for a particular designation, such as "FB," "RB" or "★." There is no Designation Review service for "✦," which must be submitted for ReGrade. For varieties, use VarietyPlus and separate from Designation Review. Select High Value Designation Review for coins valued over \$10,000.
High Value Designation Review	\$50 per coin	Select High Value Designation Review for coins valued over \$10,000.
Appearance Review	\$0 per coin	A service for review of an NGC-certified coin you believe is overgraded.
Return Mint Packaging	\$5 per form	For example: capsules, Certificates of Authenticity and Mint boxes. If capsules are cracked during coin removal, they will not be returned. Does not include shipping expenses if required.

NGC IMAGING SERVICES	FEE PER COIN (USD)	DESCRIPTION
Internet Imaging	\$5	Digital imaging for coins submitted under any of NGC's grading and service tiers. Consists of accurate high-resolution images of the obverse and reverse of the coin, shown encapsulated in its NGC holder. Sent by email. Applies to all coins on the form.
NGC Photo Vision	\$8	High-resolution JPG images of the obverse and reverse and a side-by-side JPG with the NGC logo and NGC submission number. Sent by email.

Declared value MUST represent fair market value and NGC reserves the right to make adjustments for undervalued items.

NCS HONG KONG SERVICES & FEES

A \$15 handling fee per invoice applies to all submissions in addition to the following fees.



NCS is the official conservation service of the ANA, PNG and the Macau Numismatic Society.

NCS CONSERVATION TIERS	FEE PER COIN (USD)	REQUIREMENTS
Standard Conservation	4% Fair Market Value (FMV) (\$25 minimum fee)†	All coins. 4% Fair Market Value (FMV) (\$25 minimum fee). NGC grading fees additional. If NCS believes that conservation will not benefit a coin submitted under the Standard Conservation tier, it will be transferred to NGC for grading and only the NGC grading fees will apply.
NCS Gold	\$30	All uncertified gold coins, both vintage and modern, except ancient coins and coins requiring an NGC Oversize Holder (over 45 mm). Maximum value \$3,000 per coin. Fee includes NCS conservation only. NGC grading fees additional. If NCS believes that conservation will not benefit a coin submitted under the NCS Gold tier, it will be transferred to NGC for grading and only the NGC grading fees will apply.
NCS Modern	\$11	All uncertified coins 1955 to present, except coins requiring an NGC Oversize Holder (over 45 mm). Maximum value \$2,000 per coin. Fee includes NCS conservation only. NGC grading fees additional. If NCS believes that conservation will not benefit a coin submitted under the NCS Modern tier, it will be transferred to NGC for grading and only the NGC grading fees will apply.

Declared value **MUST** represent fair market value and NCS reserves the right to make adjustments for undervalued items.

†NGC Oversize Holder fee of \$15 per coin applies to coins over 45 mm in diameter.
