

# PMG HONG KONG SERVICES & FEES

Effective January 20, 2026



PMG is the official grading service of the ANA, PNG and the Macau Numismatic Society.

For submissions to Certified Collectibles Group — International Hong Kong Limited (CCG Hong Kong) only.

US and world notes must be submitted on separate submission forms.

All fees and maximum values are US dollars.

Fees include round trip shipping and insurance between CCG Hong Kong and PMG Headquarters.

A \$15 handling fee per invoice applies to all submissions.

For current estimated turnaround times, visit [PMGnotes.hk/services](http://PMGnotes.hk/services). Turnaround times are estimates and are NOT guaranteed.

The Friedberg or Pick number should be referenced on the submission form when submitting notes listed in either of these references. An attribution fee of \$5 per catalog number is charged when notes submitted are not accompanied by an accurate catalog number. All fees and maximum values in USD.

A \$10 adjustment fee will be charged for submission forms that must be modified prior to processing. This includes forms with more than one tier listed and adjustments in tier levels due to undervalued notes. Choose only one tier per submission form.

Unless requested otherwise by the customer on the submission form, PMG will generally encapsulate notes in the smallest possible holder if doing so allows them to fit in one of PMG's standard holder sizes. For example, a vertically oriented note will be encapsulated in a horizontally oriented PMG standard holder if it will fit. Notes that require the PMG Oversize Holder or Custom Holder will generally be encapsulated according to the note's orientation.

Please limit non-bulk submissions to 50 notes per submission form. For bulk submissions, please limit to 100 notes per submission form. Use multiple submission forms as needed.

Unlimited WalkThrough	\$325 + 2% Fair Market Value (FMV)	Unlimited value.
<b>Bulk Submission</b>		<b>Applies to all bulk submissions:</b> Notes valued up to \$300. <b>Fifty (50)-note minimum.</b> The following notes are <b>NOT</b> eligible for bulk submission tiers: error notes and Chinese notes issued from 1948 through the 1953 First Series notes (Pick numbers 800 to 859).
Consecutive Bulk	\$15	All serial numbers must be in consecutive order. Multiple catalog numbers are allowed, but there must be at least 25 notes per catalog number. All vintage or modern notes are accepted provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
Modern Bulk — Mixed Types (1957–Present)	\$18	Notes may be a mix of catalog numbers and / or serial numbers. All notes issued 1957 to present are accepted, provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
Vintage Bulk — Mixed Types (Pre-1957)	\$23	Notes may be a mix of catalog numbers and / or serial numbers. All notes issued before 1957 are accepted, provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
<b>Bond and Stock Certificates</b>		Certificate maximum size 580 mm wide x 740 mm high. Grading fee includes Oversize Holder or Custom Holder, as applicable. See <a href="http://PMGnotes.hk/news/article/7703/">PMGnotes.hk/news/article/7703/</a> for complete information.
Economy (ESB)	\$55	Bond and stock certificates valued up to \$1,000. Request "ESB" in bold letters on the submission form.
High Value (HSB)	\$85	Bond and stock certificates valued over \$1,000. Request "HSB" in bold letters on the submission form.
<b>PMG ADD-ON SERVICES</b>	<b>FEE PER NOTE (USD)</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
On-site Grading	Tier Fee + \$5	Use this service if you are submitting to a PMG On-site Grading Event. Enter the name and date of the event to which you are submitting. See <a href="http://PMGnotes.hk/events/">PMGnotes.hk/events/</a> for more information.
Early Releases / First Releases	Tier Fee + \$8	Use this service to receive either the EARLY RELEASES or FIRST RELEASES designation for qualifying notes. Select only one. Visit <a href="http://PMGnotes.hk/cutoffdates/">PMGnotes.hk/cutoffdates/</a> for a list of eligible notes and submission cutoff dates.
Special Label	Tier Fee + \$8	Use this service to request a special PMG label. For a list of special PMG labels, visit <a href="http://PMGnotes.hk/labels/">PMGnotes.hk/labels/</a> . Request desired label number on the submission form. <b>Note:</b> Use different forms for different special labels.
PMG Oversize Holder	Tier Fee + \$20	Select this service for notes and / or sheets 195 mm wide x 120 mm high to 205 mm wide x 220 mm high in size. Must be submitted on a separate form. PMG reserves the right to use a larger holder and charge the submitter the appropriate fees for notes that are close to the maximum dimensions of the requested holder type.
Custom Holder	Tier Fee + \$50	Select the Custom Holder for notes and / or sheets sized between 205 mm wide x 220 mm high and 580 mm wide x 740 mm high. Must be submitted on a separate form. See PMG Services & Fees for current pricing.
Variety	Tier Fee + \$10	Additional attribution not mentioned in Friedberg, Haxby, Criswell, Schwan, Charlton & the <i>Standard Catalog of World Paper Money</i> , as well as all "fr" fluorescence attributions for Chinese RMB notes. The Variety fee applies when requested regardless of whether PMG determines the note to be a recognized variety.
Pedigree	Tier Fee + \$5	A pedigree can be added to the certification label to indicate a note's past or present ownership. The Pedigree service must also be selected for all notes with a courtesy autograph. To pedigree a note to a previous owner, that collector or collection must be considered to be significant by PMG and sufficient documentation (including copies of auction lots and plates, sales invoices or other backup) must be provided to confirm the requested pedigree. You can also pedigree a note to yourself, typically without providing any documentation. To add a pedigree to notes already encapsulated by PMG, also select an applicable PMG ReHolder service. Print clearly on the submission form exactly how you want the pedigree to appear on the PMG label. All pedigrees are subject to PMG's approval. The Pedigree fee applies when requested regardless of whether PMG determines the note to have an eligible pedigree.
ReGrade	Tier Fee	If you disagree with a grade previously assigned by PMG, you may submit the note for review for a higher grade. The note must be intact in its PMG holder. Choose a grading tier according to the note's value and the tier requirements. Notes are graded according to PMG's grading standards, and a higher grade is not guaranteed. Fees are not refunded if a higher grade is not received. A note submitted for ReGrade will be removed from its PMG holder by PMG staff and encapsulated with a new PMG holder, label and certification number, even if the grade does not change. All notes submitted under ReGrade are subject to the terms and conditions of the PMG Guarantee. In the unlikely event that the grade is determined to be lower through ReGrade, the ReGrade will be converted into an Appearance Review under the PMG Guarantee.
CrossOver	Tier Fee	Review of a note held by PCGS Currency, PCGS Gold Shield, PCGS Banknote Grading, PCGS CMC or PCGS Banknote (the "PCGS Brands") for PMG certification. A note will be removed from its holder only if PMG believes that the note will meet or exceed PMG's standards for the grade assigned by the PCGS Brand. If PMG does not believe that the note will meet PMG's standards, the note will be returned in its PCGS-branded holder and the grading fee will be refunded less a \$10 processing charge per note. If you would like the note in a PCGS-branded holder certified by PMG regardless of the PMG grade that it will receive, write CROSS AT ANY GRADE in bold letters on the PMG Submission Form. PMG's grading fees will be discounted by 20% for CrossOver submissions designated as "CROSS AT ANY GRADE." ReHolder	\$15	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes valued up to \$10,000.
High Value ReHolder	\$55	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes valued over \$10,000.
Oversize ReHolder	\$20	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets 195 mm wide x 120 mm high to 205 mm wide x 220 mm high in size. Notes valued up to \$10,000.
High Value Oversize ReHolder	\$100	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets 195 mm wide x 120 mm high to 205 mm wide x 220 mm high in size. Notes valued over \$10,000.
Custom ReHolder	\$50	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets sized between 205 mm wide x 220 mm high and 580 mm wide x 740 mm high. Notes valued up to \$10,000.
High Value Custom ReHolder	\$110	A note in a PMG holder can be placed in a new holder. Notes and / or sheets sized between 205 mm wide x 220 mm high and 580 mm wide x 740 mm high. Notes valued over \$10,000.
<b>PMG IMAGING SERVICES</b>	<b>FEE PER NOTE (USD)</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Internet Imaging	\$5 each	If chosen, PMG provides digital imaging for notes submitted under any of its grading and service tiers at \$5 per note. Consists of accurate high-resolution images (sent by email) of the front and back of the note, shown encapsulated in its PMG holder. Applies to all notes on the form.

Appearance Review	\$0 per note	Review of a PMG note you believe is overgraded.
Return Packaging	\$5 per form	Examples include Certificates of Authenticity (COAs), auction tags, and folders / boxes. If sending COAs or auction tags for verification purposes, please send copies. Do not send originals.
