## ICSID Book Launch Series

In this new book published by Oxford University Press, Susan D. Franck draws on cognitive psychology and hard data to explore the reality of investment treaty arbitration, identify core demographics and basic information on outcomes, and drill down on the costs of parties' counsel and arbitral tribunals. It offers a nuanced analysis of how and when cost-shifting occurs, parses tribunals' rationalization of cost assessments, and models the variables most likely to predict costs, using data to point the way towards evidence-based normative reform.
