Hands-On Learning:

Attendees will break into groups to design searches for each class and difficulty level. Dog-handler teams will run the searches blind, with the participants acting as the judge. After the search the instructor will discuss the search design, hide placement, and judging performance of the group. Working attendees will break into groups.
