## ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season and lame dogs may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.) If you have any questions, please contact the event secretary.

**NOT REGISTERED WITH AKC:** You can register your dog through the AKC Canine Partners program the day of event. Breed will be marked as "All American Dog." Contact Field Secretary for more details! Qualified runs during this event will be counted toward your title.

## ENTRY INFORMATION

These events will be conducted in accordance with the [AKC Fast CAT Regulations](#). The Event Committee shall have the authority to decide upon any matter arising which is not already specifically addressed in the Fast CAT Regulations. This includes matters related to the event that may occur before, during or after the event. Should a situation arise where the application of a Regulation is open for interpretation, the Event Committee shall decide how it will be handled.

Upon submitting your online entry you will receive a green checkmark with a thank you message – that confirms your entry. There will be a button at the bottom of the checkmark if you wish to download a receipt. An email notification summarizing the info in your entry will also be emailed to you.

**ERRORS ON ENTRIES:** Owners are responsible for the accuracy of the information required on the entry form. Changes, additions, or corrections to an entry, entry substitutions, or cancellations by the owner must be received in writing (email accepted) by the Event Secretary prior to the closing date of the trial. Other means of notification will not be accepted.

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or hand delivery. UPS and FedEx mail may be sent to the Event Secretary's address above. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the Secretary's address without a signature being required! It is the exhibitor's sole responsibility to assure their entry is delivered by the closing date and time. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A twenty-five (\$30) dollar collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check. Exhibitors may only submit paper entries the Entry Form provided with in this premium list or the downloadable PDF file published on the event website or the link provide for online entries. Please do not submit pre-filled out generic entry forms; your entry will not be accepted. *Returned or postdated checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry.*

## SCHEDULING

Both events will be run concurrently. All handlers must have dogs inspected prior to running. Dogs are assigned a running order after entries are received. As a courtesy the entry form will ask for preferred run time and the Secretary will give every effort to accommodate, however it is not guaranteed. Run times will be posted to [www.akc.org/akcfastcatinvitational](http://www.akc.org/akcfastcatinvitational) following sometime after the close of entries. If you are late for your run time, you will be moved to the end of the run order. Please arrive to the field 30 mins. prior to your scheduled run time. Exhibitors are responsible for knowing their dog's run time and to be waiting to run in the queue outside the course after having passed through the roll call / inspection station. Any dog not present by the time the test ends, will be considered absent.

After entries close a list of the running order will be available online. For those who sign up to receive text messages when to [text message sign up](#), an alert notification will be sent that run times have been posted online.

## COURSE CONDITIONS

The Fast CAT course and setup shall adhere to the AKC Fast CAT Regulations. The course will be outdoors on a grassy field and completely fenced with usual temporary fencing. A drag lure system will be used. The lure will be a white plastic bag. Each dog will be announced and a scoreboard with the MPH and seconds will be displayed. In the event the main timer does not trip, the time recorded from the 2<sup>nd</sup> backup timer will be used. All recorded times are final. The run out will be 65 yards. The width of the track will be approximately 20 to 25 feet wide.

Exhibitors and spectators will be required to leave ample room trackside and not stand or congregate along the course fencing during official runs. Reminder cones may be visible on the field about 20 ft. off the trackside. The course will be located at the back of the Robert Centre off their parking lot which sits next to Ralph's American Grill. There will a large grass field that runs parallel to Gano Road.

Attendees must show respect in the keeping the Fast CAT field as well as any other part of the Roberts Centre as they found it and pickup after their dog. Free baggies will be on hand at the secretary's desk. Any participant failing to do so may be excused without the benefit

of a refund if the Event Committee deems the participant to be in violation of this requirement.

Bathrooms will be provided in the Roberts Centre which is a short walk across a parking lot from the Fast CAT field.

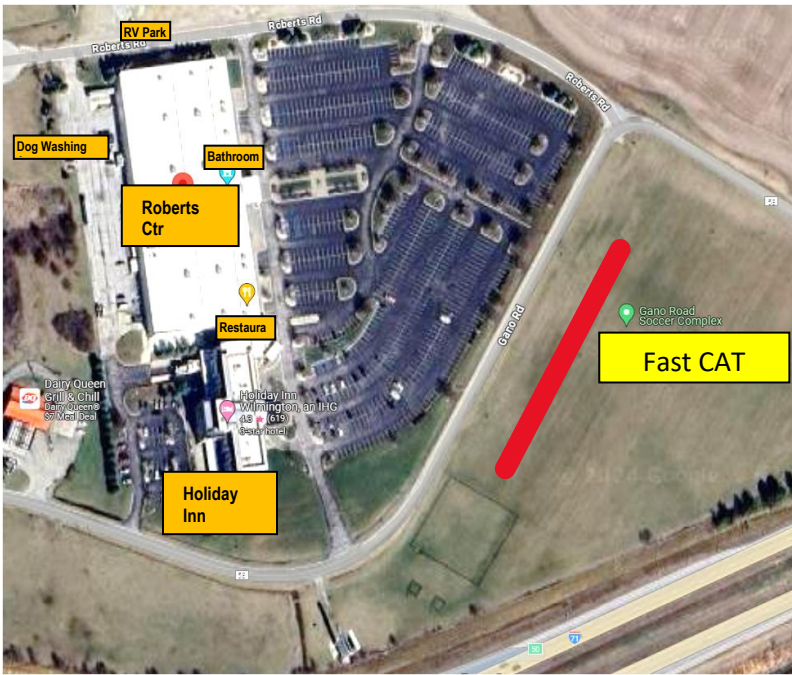

## HOLIDAY INN ROBERTS CENTRE RULES AND REGULATIONS - (For Guests)

- All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated.
  - Sheets of plastic provided to guests must be placed under the crates. Up to four dogs will be permitted per room.
  - Housekeepers will NOT have to service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Moreover, they will be required to report this rule violation to hotel management.
  - A pet fee of Current Hotel Rates will be charged for each room in which a dog is housed per stay. Rooms found to house a dog/animal that is not secured in a crate will be charged a higher pet fee. Individual room occupants will be assessed for any damage or destruction to their room – including but not limited to – damage to sheets, towels, flooring, furniture, carpet, etc.
  - Dogs will be bathed in designated areas for dog washing. There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms and no hotel towels will be used for this purpose.
  - Rooms where evidence of dog grooming in the restrooms is found will be assessed an excessive room cleaning fee.
  - Any guests not adhering to the rules, regulations or policies of the Roberts Centre will be asked to leave the hotel immediately.
  - Dogs will not be permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas, including the swimming pools, and any other areas to be stipulated as “non-dog” locations.
  - Dogs will not be permitted in food and beverage outlets, apart from those assisting the disabled.
  - The hotel will provide trash receptacles in the designated exercised areas for deposit of dog waste.
  - Pick up and removal of dog waste will be the responsibility of each dog owner/handler.
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## HOLIDAY INN ROBERTS CENTRE - RV LOT RESERVATION INFORMATION

The Roberts Centre has 26 RV Spots which are Full Hook-ups these spots are charged at a rate of \$40 per night / all other parking is considered dry parking and is charged at a rate of \$25 per night. GUESTS MUST PRE-REGISTER FOR RV PARKING. RV availability is on a first come first serve basis.

*Payment* - All checks must be payable to *The Roberts Centre*. You may also pay by credit card. Payment in full is required when reservation is made. Paid reservations must be received no later than two weeks before the event that you will be attending. No refunds will be issued after this date. All RV parking is on a pre-paid reservation basis.

*Reserved Spot Assignments/Requirements* - All spaces will be pre-assigned. “Holding” or changing spaces is not permitted. If you would like to be next to someone please designate it on your reservation form. Reservation of additional RV Parking spaces is not permitted. This includes no cones, rope, string, other vehicles, x-pens, mats, or any other means of reserving parking space. *RVs MUST NOT be parked within 6ft of Roberts Road or in front of the area where the hookups begin – this is for guest safety and must be followed.*

One additional vehicle is permitted overnight per RV space reserved. No parking of any additional vehicles in your assigned space is permitted. All vehicles must be self-contained. Please be courteous when parking. Leave enough room for your slide outs, awnings and vehicle.

*Cleaning and Maintenance of RV Spot Requirements - It is the individual guest's responsibility (when group is NOT handling RV Reservations) to ensure they are leaving their reserved RV Parking spot the way they found it without damaging the spot or leaving behind trash/waste. It is required that the guest dispose of all trash, waste, bedding, etc. from the reserved RV spot prior to departure. If the guest requires trash bags, they can be purchased from our front desk or banquets department for \$1.00 per bag. ### RIBBONS

A light blue ribbon will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score. A special ribbon for dogs completing titles will be given.

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**NON-DOG AREAS** - Dogs will not be permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas, including the swimming pools, and any other areas to be stipulated as “non-dog” locations. Dogs will not be permitted in food and beverage outlets, with the exception of those assisting the disabled. Owners must comply with all facility rules.

**ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH** - Dogs must be on leash, held by the handler at all times while on the event grounds except when inside the course area. Failure to maintain control of a dog may result in an Event Committee hearing. **SPECIAL TRAINING COLLARS ARE PROHIBITED.**

**CLEANUP** - Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the event grounds and all hotels. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be asked to leave the event grounds without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY-** The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the regulations of the

AKC. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site or be subject to disciplinary action per the *AKC Dealing with Misconduct* book. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**HEALTH & VACCINATIONS** - Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. A copy of a dog's vaccination record, including a current rabies certificate, must be present for all dogs at the event.

**CRATING** - Space under the tent will be marked off for crating. Spaces if needed can be used first come first serve. The parking lot is in very close proximity to the field and most prefer to crate in their vehicles.

## BASIC FAST CAT INFORMATION

Fast CAT Test is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. It is meant to be a fun and healthy activity of interest to any dog owner. Dogs run singularly.

### **How are Fast CAT Points and Titles Awarded?**

The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into MPS.

A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPS to determine the number of points earned.

The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers.

18 inches or greater = handicap of 1.0

12 inches to less than 18 inches = handicap of 1.5

Below 12 inches = handicap of 2.0

Points = MPS multiplied by the dog's handicap.

The inspection committee reserves the right to measure if necessary.

Fast CAT titles are suffix titles earned at designated milestones.

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT = every additional 500 points

The [top 20 fastest dogs](#) by breeds are published on the AKC website.

## **Course and Equipment**

**Safety:** Safety is of utmost importance. It is the responsibility of the event committee to ensure the safety of the course, equipment and conduct of those involved with the event. It is recommended that the event committee run a test dog prior to the start of the event to ensure that the equipment functions properly and all personnel understand their jobs.

**The Finish:** It is recommended an owner or someone familiar with the dog be at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course is completed.

**Timing Devices:** Electronic timers will be used. The time to complete the 100-yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second. The time starts when any part of the dog breaks

the electronic beam at the start line. The time stops when any part of the dog crosses the finish line. Stop watches will be used as a backup if the electronic timers don't function.

**Lure Equipment:** A drag line system will be used.

**Lure:** A white plastic bag will be used for the lure.

The **Huntmaster** has control of the course. The huntmaster is in charge of all dogs and handlers on the field, shall ensure handlers understand safe release and retrieval procedures, shall ensure the lure is properly positioned, shall ensure the lure operator, timers and starting line signal person are ready, shall signal the lure operator to start the lure and shall give the verbal signal "tallyho" to release the dog.

## GENERAL INFO

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test or trial.
2. Dogs not present by the end of the test will be scratched.
3. Each entry will be examined at inspection. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded.
4. Dogs will be inspected before each Event.
5. Run order will be based on order set by the field committee. We will separate the running of multiple dogs handled by a single handler. If a dog is late for their run time they will run at the end of the running order.
6. Dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. Owners should be aware that there is a chance that tags hanging from the collar could become entangled on something during the run. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.
7. Drag line system will be used. Lure is a white plastic bag.
8. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
9. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
10. Control of dogs strictly enforced on leash at all times except when running.
11. Clean up and carry out all trash.
12. Please pick up after your dog and put in receptacles provided at site.
