

E-Z Deal Card Changes – Bidding in the 21st Century

(This idea was submitted by Norman Mobley of Summerfield FL.)

Suggestion: Teachers can use their old decks of Bidding E-Z Deal Cards to teach the updated Bidding in the 21st Century course by changing the direction of the cards affected by the revision. In total only 13 cards need to be changed in the old decks to save the cost of buying new decks of E-Z Deals. Changes can be made by cutting ¼ inch squares of good self-adhesive white paper. Place the square over the change to be made, making sure it sticks, then print the new direction on it. You may have to use a dab of glue to make the square secure. Here are the four deals that changed:

Lesson 3, Deal 3

6D was in W hand, now in N
3H was in N hand, now in W
QC was in S hand, now in E
JC was in E hand, now in S

Lesson 3, Deal 4

7H was in W, now in N
JH was in N, now in W
QH was in S, now in W
AH was in W, now in S
QD was in S, now in E
5D was in E, now in S

Lesson 5, Deal 3

JC was in E, now in S
5C was in S, now in E

Lesson 6, Deal 4

JD was in W, now in S
10D was in S, now in W
