## South Carolina teacher receives ABTA honor

For a long time, Kathie Walsh says, “I thought I knew how to play bridge.” She found out different when she moved to Hilton Head SC in 1999.

Just retired, Walsh started playing duplicate in Hilton Head and found out the truth about her game. Determined to improve, she hit upon a plan.

“I decided the best way to learn was to teach,” says Walsh, whose efforts to help others learn the game earned her 2011 Teacher of the Year honors from the American Bridge Teachers Association. The award is sponsored by Master Point Press, the world’s largest publisher of bridge books.

ABTA President Joyce Penn notes that Walsh’s students gave her high recommendations, “and her teaching material is great.”

Barbara Seagram has visited Hilton Head and seen Walsh in action. “She has built such an enormous bridge community there. She nurtures her students and has such charm and grace.”

Walsh lived in the Philadelphia area before retiring to South Carolina. She taught in high schools and colleges in the area before retiring in 1998. She and her husband moved to South Carolina because they had visited there previously and were favorably impressed.

Walsh became a bridge teacher in 2002, taking the Teacher Accreditation Program taught by Audrey Grant at the bridge club in Hilton Head. Her plan to improve by teaching paid off in 2003, when she became a Life Master.

Walsh’s classes started with slightly more than a dozen people, but now often exceed 100. She teaches bridge three times a week. She designs the classes for people who can’t or don’t want to take an eight-week course. “I tell people that even if the class is too easy

Snow connected with Cotterman, a TD working in Paducah, and they played a session in a side game. Snow told Cotterman he was planning to attend the Summer NABC in Toronto but “I don’t know anyone in Canada.”

Cotterman sent an email to Seagram, who wrote back that Cram, a retired teacher, was a possible partner.

Cram and Snow connected via email and made dates to play together through most of the NABC.

In their first session on Thursday afternoon, they were having a good time. “He’s very nice to play with,” said Cram, who has been playing duplicate about four years.

Snow also professed to be having a good time and, noting that the two will be playing nearly every day in Toronto, added with a laugh, “Look out, world!”

The semifinal round of the von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs begins today with two Californians holding a slim carryover lead. Bruce Noda, Madera, and Mark Ralph, San Francisco, begin play with a score of 1208.82, just ahead of Curtis Cheek, Las Vegas, and Lynn Deas, Schenectady NY, with 1198.53.

Very close, in third place, are Mark and Stasha Cohen of Glen Ridge NJ, followed by Michael Cait, Downsview ON, and Roger Allen, Victoria BC.

Two other flights in the LM Pairs will be playing semifinals today.

The leaders in the Bruce Life Master Pairs 0-5000 entering today’s semifinal round are two players from opposite ends of the continent – Jay Bandler, Piedmont CA, and Cordelia Menges, New York City. Their carryover score of 391.31 put them nearly 20 matchpoints ahead of the second-place qualifiers – Michael Lane and David Platnick of Charlottesville VA.

## Check Cashing and Bridge Bucks at the Toronto NABC



Canadian checks for the exact amount of entry and U.S. checks for the exact amount of entry will be accepted at the entry sale.

Entry fees are payable in U.S. or Canadian funds. Change will be given in the currency tendered whenever possible. Small change will be given in Canadian funds.

The check cashing desk will be at the Royal York on Friday, July 22, at noon. Additional locations and hours will be posted in the Daily Bulletin. Checks are only accepted during check cashing hours.

U.S. checks for amounts greater than entry (and less than the allowable daily limit) will be cashed for Canadian funds at the current exchange rate. Bridge Bucks will be sold for \$20 U.S. The current exchange rate will be used when purchasing Bridge Bucks with Canadian funds.

U.S. currency will not be exchanged for Canadian currency, neither at the check cashing desk nor at the entry sale.

# JUST FOR NEW PLAYERS

## The crossruff

Ruff or trump? Are the words synonymous? Players sometimes use the words interchangeably, but trump is technically a noun, not a verb. Ruff can be either, as in “I ruffed two hearts in dummy” or “Declarer took two ruffs in hand.” Consider the common usages: You can “give partner a ruff” but not “give a trump.” “Diamonds are trumps” but not “diamonds are ruffs.” When you are talking about using a trump to win a trick against a plain suit, the preferred term is ruff.



Okay, on to the lesson. If we ask a new player how he plans to make a contract, you often hear, “I’m going to crossruff.” There is something joyous about a crossruff that excites the average bridge player! Contrary to popular opinion, however, the true crossruff is rare.

It is just a fact (memorize this fact!) that ruffing in your hand rarely gets you extra tricks. Ruffing in dummy – when dummy has the short trump holding – is the best way to get extra tricks by ruffing.

On the following deal, the crossruff is definitely not the winning strategy.

In a true crossruff, you must not draw trumps. You need to have them in dummy and in your hand. Therefore, if you own a long, good side suit (non-trumps) (e.g., A-K-5-4 opposite Q-J-6-3) you must not use the crossruff technique.

Check out this hand where South is in 7♥! Yikes! Only 28 high-card points exist in the two hands.

South has three club losers. If she crossruffs this hand, she will lose the ability to pull trumps and then she will be unable to “enjoy” playing the diamond suit, as opponents will then ruff the diamonds.

South must ruff his low clubs in dummy, returning to his hand once with the ♦Q and once more by ruffing one heart only in hand. The heart ruff is just for purposes of communication with South hand. Declarer must be careful to ruff the third club with dummy’s ♥A so that he will have a lower spade to get to back to his hand to pull the trumps. After trumps are all gone, declarer can now play diamonds and claim: “The rest are mine.”

On the following deal, declarer can succeed with a couple of different lines of play, including a crossruff.

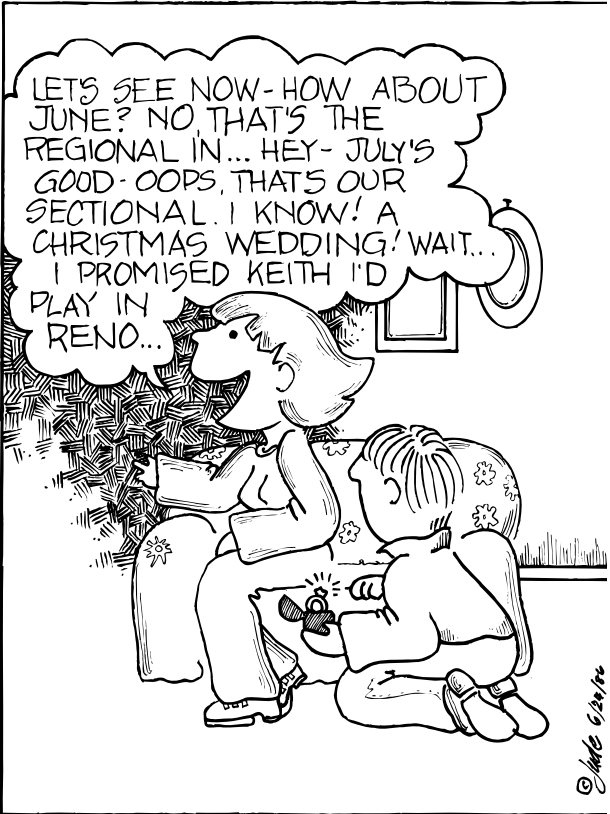

South plays in 5♦ on the lead of the ♥K. The easiest way to 11 tricks is to win the black aces and ruff losers back and forth, getting down to ♦A Q in hand and ♦K J in dummy. You will have all the tricks you need without having to guess the right play in hearts.

A key point to consider before embarking on a crossruff is the cashing of outside winners before starting to ruff.

Consider this deal:

You are South and find yourself in 6♥. Luckily for you, West does not find the trump lead, which would defeat your contract. Instead, he starts with the ♦Q (not unreasonable). You win in dummy and see that if you can take all eight of your trumps separately, you can add those to two heart tricks and two minor-suit aces to get to 12 tricks.

You must, however, cash your heart winners before starting to crossruff, because you will be ruffing diamonds and clubs, and West has only two clubs. If you have not cashed your heart winners, West will discard a heart on the third round of clubs and ruff one of your heart winners (and you still have a heart loser).

Cash the top hearts, breathe a sigh of relief when no one ruffs, then start ruffing back and forth. In the end, West will have to ruff his partner’s heart winner as you claim your slam. Well done!

## Thinking Bridge

**Opening lead:** ♥6. Lead a major before a minor with two four-card suits of relatively equal strength.

**Bidding commentary:** As South, your hand should be revalued to 18 points given the strong five-card suit. Balanced hands with 17 high-card

points and a strong five-card suit are too strong to open 1NT and should open the five-card suit intending to jump in notrump next.

As North, raise to 3NT with balanced distribution rather than rebid the five-card heart suit. It is an exception to rebid a five-card suit in this sequence. Normally the rebid shows a six-card suit. If the suit is exceptionally strong (K-Q-J-10-x) it can be treated as a six-card suit. There are checkback methods available for North to find out if you have three hearts.

**Defensive commentary:** As East, if declarer plays low at trick one, win the queen and shift to the ♦Q. Partner is marked with four spades, probably including the ace, which means the most your side can get is three spades tricks if you return the suit. Partner must have some outside honor card and your best chance is to hope it is the ♦A. If declarer started with 17 HCP, partner could have the ♦A.

**Play commentary:** As West, you have 10 sure tricks between clubs and hearts once you get in, and you can’t stand a diamond shift from East, so go up with the ♥K to reduce the chance of East getting in.

## KOs are OK!

Knockout teams are popular with newer players. Do you know how they work? Here’s a quick summary:

**Knockout Teams:** an event in which a team (of four, five or six players, with four playing at a time) plays another team. The losers are eliminated or “knocked out” while the winners play other winners until only one winning team remains.

**Bracketed Knockout Teams:** a KO event in which teams are divided into groups (usually of 8, 16 or 32 teams) based on their masterpoint holdings. The top group (Bracket I) and all other groups compete in a separate event with their own set of winners.

of Canadians take a slim lead into the first of two semifinal rounds today.

The leaders – by less than a board and a half – are Peter Deluca, Woodbridge ON, and John McWhinnie, Hillsburgh ON.

Their carryover score of 362 put them just ahead of a pair of Colorado players – David Corbin and Kurt Simmons of Boulder – with a score of 360.61.

Not far behind them, with 357.36, are Bill Lough, Edina MN, and William Cummings, Monticello MN.

All three events conclude on Sunday.

Those who decided their ♣K was working overtime were sadder, if not wiser, at the end of the deal.

If South opens the bidding, East-West might well stay out of game.

Say you play 4♥ as East, though, on a diamond lead after that player has opened 1♦. It looks natural to win this in your hand in case the lead is from the ♦K J.

This would indeed be the only way home if South had both spade honors and all the minor-suit honors, but then he might have led a trump instead.

The winning line is to take the ♦Q at trick one and draw trumps, ending in the West hand. Now you take a spade finesse, win the diamond return, eliminate the spades and exit with a diamond to South to endplay him to give you a ruff-sluff or lead clubs for you.

## The Insider

The Insider cleared Customs this morning and arrived at the Royal York fresh and ready to go. Upon arrival, he was informed that the Supreme Commander was also due to arrive today. With no time to check the number of pillows, the softness of the bed or any of the other 235 details the S.C. wants attended to prior to his arrival, the Insider just ordered more bottles of single malt and hoped for the best. No word from the 47th-floor executive suite — must have been the right decision.

The NABC planners make a trip to the site of the NABC about a month before the tournament. They do this to meet with all the various departments at the hotels. There were several other examples of things going slightly wrong that could have been solved by listening better and acknowledging the experience the planners have gained over the many years of putting on NABCs. The Insider is sure the planners have gotten their message across, and all of you will see an improvement today.

Ask Me Girl has been hard at work at both hotels, but has been doing her game-time question answering at the Sheraton. The Insider is sure she will break away and make a triumphant entrance to the Royal York so that all of her loyal NABC+ fans can finally get their questions answered. Boss Baum took the day off from bridge, but Mrs. Boss was hard at work at the table. The Services guys are also split between the two hotels and, so far, have not been able to get together for the traditional Toronto-train-station-best-in-the-world-hot-dog. Maybe today. After looking at the line at the LM Pairs sale, the Insider ran for the PATH. But the TDs did a fantastic job selling the entries and getting the game started on time and the Insider returned to take full credit for everything.

or too hard they will learn something,” she says, and she notes that “I’m still learning.”

Some of her students have been taking her classes for years, some going back as far as a decade.

She says anyone interested in teaching bridge should “just do it. There’s nothing to

lose, and it will help your game and help bridge.”

Walsh is the second straight teacher from South Carolina to earn Teacher of the Year honors, following 2010 winner Tina Radding of Charleston.

Announcement of the Teacher of the Year is one of several functions of the ABTA, which convenes annually at the Summer NABC.

At the same time Walsh’s honor was being announced, bridge teacher Gerry La Chance of Collingwood ON was honored with a special ABTA award for service to the game and the profession.

Earlier in the week, the ABTA hosted a luncheon that drew nearly 120 teachers.

## Guesswork

This deal, which comes from the quarterfinal round of the Grand National Teams Championship Flight, will require you to guess well as declarer in 3NT:

West leads a standard ♣2, and when you play low from dummy, East wins the jack, before returning a somewhat surprising ♣3. You play the 10 (allowing you to finesse later if necessary), which is covered by West’s king and dummy’s ace. When you unblock the ♦K, both opponents play low.

If diamonds are behaving, you have nine tricks (two spades, five diamonds and two clubs), but if they’re not, you’ll have to get the clubs right. But are they 3-3 or 4-2? Keep in mind that your only entry to the table is via the club suit.

At the table, declarer decided to play a low club to dummy’s 8. This understandable choice proved disastrous on the actual layout:

East, David Berkowitz, won the ♣9, and the defense had no trouble keeping declarer off the dummy. Declarer finished down two for a double-digit swing when the game made at the other table.

## Bid Box Alerts and Announcements

When using bid boxes, the ACBL requires that players tap the Alert strip and say “Alert” at the same time.

When making an Announcement, use the Announcement word (such as “transfer”) and tap the Alert strip at the same time.

A player who Alerts or Announces a bid must make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or Announcement has been made.

## Electronic Device Policy

The electronic device policy is revised as follows:

1. For all NABC+ rated events at NABCs: Electronic devices, including but not limited to, phones, cameras, PDAs, and others capable of sending or receiving electronic communication are excluded from the playing areas during any session of play. This does not apply to health-related equipment.

2. For all events at an NABC other than a NABC+ rated event: Except for health-related equipment, or by permission of the Director-in-Charge of the tournament, cell phones, audible pagers or similar equipment may not be operated or operable in any manner in the playing area during a session of play. Any such equipment must not be visible during the session. Sponsoring organizations of other ACBL-sanctioned events are encouraged to adopt a similar policy.

3. These restrictions in numbers 1 and 2 above apply to all pairs, team members, captains, coaches, play recorders (except those designated by ACBL) and kibitzers and are in force throughout any actual playing session or segment of play.

4. A violation of any of the restrictions in numbers 1 and 2 above will result in a disciplinary penalty of one full board (12 IMPs at that form of scoring) for the first offense. A second offense will result in disqualification from the event for the pair/team. Kibitzers violating this policy will be removed from the playing area for the remainder of the session.

## Shuttle info

Shuttles are provided between the Sheraton Centre and Fairmont Royal York.

One shuttle will run continuously between the hotels from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. Additionally, a second shuttle will run during these times: 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., and 4:30 to 8:30 p.m.

## Monitoring

At this and future North American Championships, ACBL will be monitoring NABC+ events with visible, real-time cameras. The images will be recorded and will be available for later official inspection and review.

By general monitoring of the session and participants’ behavior, ACBL has another source of information that may be useful in determining facts and settling issues arising from some types of ethical and behavioral complaints or actions. Please summon a director if a problem occurs at the table.

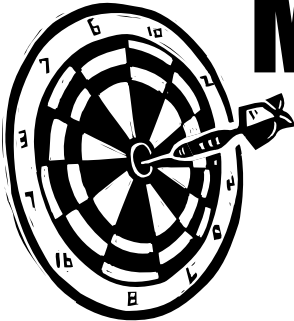

### Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the Standard American Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6-board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.

The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.

### Slow play notice

If you are a habitually slow player, be aware that the ACBL Board of Directors unanimously approved this motion at the Fall NABC in 2010:

When a pair has fallen behind, it is incumbent on them to make up the time lost as quickly as possible whether at fault or not. All players are expected to make a concerted effort to catch up when they have fallen behind, regardless of the reason for their lateness.

In the absence of compelling evidence to the contrary, the director should presume that a pair finishing a round late by more than two or three minutes on more than one occasion during a session is responsible for the lateness. There is a strong expectation that the director will penalize such a pair. The size of a penalty will tend to increase for subsequent instances of slow play and for chronic or egregious slow play. While warnings typically will be given before a penalty is assessed, failure to do so in no way limits the director’s authority to issue a penalty. An appeal of an action taken by a TD with regard to time may be taken to the Director in Charge of the tournament, and no further.

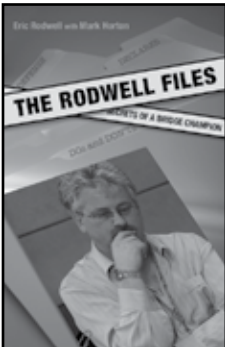
