The Infiniti FX was introduced in Australia in 2012. In 2013 the Infiniti FX was renamed QX70. The QX70 was introduced in New Zealand in 2017. The ANCAP safety rating has been updated to reflect the name change and is on the basis of testing of the FX conducted in 2009. The rating applies to variants with a 3.7 litre V6 petrol engine. V8 variants are unrated.

Dual frontal airbags, side airbags and head-protecting curtain airbags are standard equipment. Intelligent seat belt reminders are fitted to all seats. Autonomous emergency braking (AEB) is available on some variants. Occupant Protection.

The passenger compartment held its shape well in the frontal offset test. Protection from serious leg injury was marginal for the driver and passenger. Rearward pedal movement was excessive and penalties were applied.



This vehicle scored 15.94 out of 36 points (Marginal). The bumper provided predominantly marginal protection for pedestrian's legs and the front edge of the bonnet mostly poor. In most areas likely to be struck by the head of a child, protection was poor but in those areas most likely to be struck by an adult, good protection was provided. (Tested by Euro NCAP v5.1)
