


Frontal offset test at 64km/h

The tested model of VW Passat was introduced in Australia and New Zealand in 2015. This ANCAP safety rating is based on tests conducted by Euro NCAP and applies to all New Zealand variants (sedan & wagon, petrol & diesel engines). Australian variants are covered by a separate rating.

Dual frontal, side chest and side head-protecting airbags (curtains) for front row occupants are standard. A driver knee airbag is optional in New Zealand. Electronic Brake Distribution (EBD), Emergency Brake Assist (EBA) and Autonomous Emergency Braking (AEB) are also standard on NZ variants.

Occupant Protection.

Frontal Offset Test

Each body region is scored out of 4 points

Head / neck: 4.00 points
Chest: 3.56 points
Upper legs: 2.00 points
Lower legs: 3.33 points

The passenger compartment held its shape well in the frontal offset test. Pedal and steering wheel displacements were well controlled. Driver and passenger contact with the airbags was stable. All doors remained closed during the crash.

The vehicle tested by Euro NCAP had a driver knee airbag fitted as standard however the knee airbag is offered as an option on NZ variants and scoring has been adjusted.

Side Impact Test

Each body region is scored out of 4 points

Head: 4.00 points
Chest: 4.00 points
Abdomen: 4.00 points
Pelvis: 4.00 points

Good protection was provided for the driver in the side impact test. The side airbags performed well.

Pole Test

The vehicle was eligible for a side pole test because it has side curtain airbags. The vehicle scored the maximum 2 points for head protection in this test.


Pedestrian Protection.

Pedestrian Test

Scored out of 36 points

Adult & child head impacts: 15.25 points
Upper leg impacts: 2.55 points
Lower leg impacts: 6.00 points

This vehicle scored 23.80 out of 36 points (Acceptable). The bumper scored maximum points, providing good protection to pedestrians' legs in all places. The front edge of the bonnet offered some good protection to the pelvis region but was poor in other test areas. The protection offered to a pedestrian's head was predominantly good or adequate, with poor results recorded only on the stiff windscreen pillars. (Tested by Euro NCAP v8)
