






- Main battery 12 V, Left-hand drive





















High-voltage disconnect device

The high-voltage disconnect device is located on the right side of the engine compartment.






1. Operate release / 2. Push the release downwards / 3. Pull out switch

The alternative high-voltage disconnect device is located behind the cover of the fusebox in the cockpit. It is marked with an information label.








Remove cover (1) of fuse box / Cut line at marked location (2)
