RootShield Home & Garden Biological Fungicide

For Preventative Control of Root Diseases of Vegetables, Flowers, and Ornamental Plants:

For drench application to seeds, mix 1 to 3 tablespoons of RootShield® Home & Garden per gallon of water and apply with a watering can or other device to 25 feet of planting furrow before covering the seeds with soil.

For transplants, mix 1 to 3 tablespoons of RootShield Home & Garden per gallon of water and apply 1/2 - 1 cup (4 – 8 fl oz) per plant at transplanting. For new plant beds, mix 1 - 3 tablespoons of RootShield Home & Garden per gallon of water and apply at a rate of one gallon per 25 square feet.

For established beds or potted plants, mix 1-3 tablespoons RootShield Home & Garden per gallon of water and apply at a rate of one gallon per 25 square feet of plant bed or 1/2-1 cup (4 – 8 fl oz) per 4-8 in. pot.

RootShield Home & Garden is designed for application to seeds, plant roots and soil for control of plant root diseases and not for spray application to foliage or fruit.

RootShield Home and Garden may be used on the following vegetables, fruits, nuts and ornamental plants:

VEGETABLES, FRUITS AND NUTS

Berries and Small Fruits (Blackberries, Blueberries, Currants, Elderberries, Gooseberries, Huckleberries, Loganberries, Raspberries, Strawberries, Grapes and other berry crops)

Bulb Crops (Garlic, Leeks, Onions, Shallots and other bulb vegetables)

Cucurbits (Cucumbers, Melons, Gourds Pumpkins, Squash and other cucurbit crops)

Fruiting Vegetables (Eggplant, Sweet and Hot Peppers, Tomatillos, Tomatoes and other fruiting vegetables)

Herbs, Spices, and Mints

Hydroponic Crops (Cucumbers, Tomatoes, Lettuce, Herbs and Spices and other hydroponic crops)

Leafy Vegetables and Cole Crops

(Arugula, Celery, Chervil, Endive, Fennel, Lettuce (head and leaf), Parsley, Radicchio, Rhubarb, Spinach, Swiss Chard, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Collards, Kale, Kohlrabi, Mustard Greens, Asparagus and other leafy vegetable crops)

Legumes (Snap and Dry Beans, Lentils, Succulent and Dry Peas, Peanuts, Soybeans and other legume vegetables)

Pome Fruit (Pears, Quince)

Stone Fruit (Apricots, Cherries, Nectarines, Peaches, Plums, Prunes and other stone fruit)

Tree Nuts (Almonds, Beech Nuts, Brazil Nuts, Butternuts, Cashews, Chestnuts, Filberts, Hickory Nuts, Macadamia Nuts, Pecans, Pistachios, Walnuts)
