# 2024 Expedition trim level differences

## XL

The XL trim is intended for fleet buyers. Standard features include:

- Turbocharged 3.5-liter V6 engine (380 horsepower, 470 lb-ft of torque)
- 10-speed automatic transmission
- Seating for five passengers
- 18-inch wheels
- LED headlights
- Dual-zone automatic climate control
- Power-adjustable driver's seat
- Keyless entry with push-button start
- Six-speaker audio system
- 12-inch touchscreen
- Apple CarPlay and Android Auto functionality (wireless connectivity for both)
- Trailer tow package
- Ford Co-Pilot360

## King Ranch

The King Ranch builds off the Limited with:

- Two-tone paint scheme
- 22-inch wheels
- Power-deployable running boards
- Special leather upholstery
- Power-folding second-row captain's chairs
- 15.5-inch infotainment touchscreen
- 22-speaker Bang & Olufsen audio system
- Full digital instrument panel
- Surround-view camera system (gives you a top-down view of the Expedition and its surroundings for tight parking situations)

## Timberline

Builds on the XLT's features with:

- Upgraded V6 engine (440 hp, 510 lb-ft)
- Black 18-inch wheels
- All-terrain tires
- Off-road-tuned suspension
- Heavy-duty radiator
- Electronic limited-slip differential
- Low-range gearing (4WD only)
- Special exterior trim
- Unique interior upholstery
- Power-adjustable front passenger seat
- Power-adjustable pedals and steering column
- Driver's seat memory settings
- Wireless smartphone charging pad

## Platinum

The Platinum trim has the same feature upgrades as the King Ranch but without the special styling details. On top of that, you get:

- More powerful V6 (400 hp, 480 lb-ft)
- Adaptive suspension (can enhance road comfort and handling stability)
- Upgraded leather
- Wood and leather interior trim
- Massaging front seats
- Park assist (steers into a parking spot with little or no driver intervention)
- BlueCruise (Ford's semi-automated driving system that allows for hands-free driving on select highways and under certain conditions)

## Limited

The midtier Limited trim is the one we suggest going with. Besides the XLT's features and options, the Expedition Limited offers:

- 20-inch wheels
- Power liftgate
- Panoramic sunroof
- Leather upholstery
- Heated and ventilated front seats
- Heated second-row seats
- Second-row captain's chairs (seating for seven passengers)
- Power-folding second-row seats
- 12-speaker Bang & Olufsen audio system
- Navigation
- Adaptive cruise control (maintains a driver-set distance between the Expedition and the car in front)

## XLT

The XLT includes all of the XL's features, adding:

- Power-folding third-row seat (seating for eight passengers)
- Tri-zone automatic climate control





## Exceptional Towing Capacity

There are few SUVs that can tow as much as the Ford Expedition. Every 2024 model comes standard with rear-wheel drive, and is equipped with a 3.5-liter EcoBoost engine. This standard system has an impressive maximum towing capacity of 9,300 pounds. If you choose the available all-wheel drive system, your capacity lowers just 100 pounds to 9,200 pounds of maximum towing capacity.

Adding the available heavy-duty trailer tow package helps you maximize your towing experience. You can also add fun technology features, including the available pro trailer backup assist 2.0. This driver-assistance technology feature will actually take over and steer your trailer for you when you're in reverse. This feature will also help you align and attach the trailer with less effort on your part.

## Well-Equipped Infotainment System

When we talk about the Expedition experience, we have to talk about the amazing technology features, and these definitely show up in the well-equipped infotainment system. The Expedition comes standard with a stunning 12.0-inch touchscreen. Ford's Sync4 system is easy to use, with large, clear graphics. The cutting-edge software accepts over-the-air updates, so you'll always have the latest features.

Connecting your smartphone is a breeze with wireless Apple CarPlay and Android Auto, allowing you to quickly load your familiar smartphone apps. Your system also comes with a one-year trial subscription to connected navigation.



## Hands-Free Driving Capability

Consumer Reports gave Ford's hands-free active driving assistance system its top rating. This available feature helps set the Expedition apart from other vehicles, since it's on the very cutting edge of what cars can do today. The Ford BlueCruise feature allows you to remove your hands from the wheel while you're driving on 97% of the controlled-access highways within the United States and Canada.

You can reduce your stress on a long ride, connect with your passengers, and enjoy the scenic views on a long drive. Your system will take care of repositioning your SUV in the lane to move your car away from vehicles in adjacent lanes. When you want to pass a vehicle, you can tap your turn signal. This will tell the Expedition to handle a lane switch, pass the vehicle, and return to your original lane for you.

## Spacious Interior

The 2024 Expedition is a spacious SUV. The entry-level XL STX trim is a full-size SUV with plenty of space to comfortably seat five adult passengers. Every trim above this, starting with the XLT, can comfortably seat eight passengers across three rows of seating. All three rows have access to USB ports. Additionally, the SUV comes with tri-zone electronic automatic temperature control, so everyone stays comfortable on long drives.
