2023 MAZDA3 SEDAN VS. HATCHBACK SIMILARITIES

While the 2023 Mazda3 Sedan vs. Hatchback are two different vehicles, they have a lot in common. We've highlighted three ways they're similar for you here, but the truth is that you could find a lot more to pick from.

ENGINE OPTIONS

Whether you go with the hatchback or the sedan, they both feature the same engine options for you to pick from. There's only one engine option with the 2023 Mazda3, although there's both a standard engine option and a turbocharged version of the same engine.

When we take a look at the 2023 Mazda3 Sedan vs. Hatchback dimensions, the standard engine for both the 2023 Mazda3 Hatchback and the 2023 Mazda3 Sedan is a 2.5L engine that pushes 191 horsepower. Meanwhile, if you opt for the more powerful turbocharged engine, it pushes an even more impressive 250 horsepower.

For both the hatchback and sedan models, the turbocharged engine is only available on higher trim levels.

TECHNOLOGIES

While you might need to go with different trim levels to unlock the same technological features between the Mazda3 Sedan vs. Hatchback, the same technological features are available between the two different models.

From features like Apple CarPlay and Android Auto to a premium 12-speaker Bose sound system, if there's a technological feature you want, you can find it in both the hatchback and sedan models, you'll just have to find the right trim level to get the features you want!

Some great technologies you can find in both the hatchback and sedan models include:

- Frameless auto-dimming rearview mirror
- Heated front seats
- Heated steering wheel
- Dual USB audio inputs
- 8.8" infotainment system
- Windshield projected active driving display
- Traffic sign recognition

SAFETY FEATURES

Not only can you get all the same technological features between the Mazda3 Sedan vs. Hatchback, but they also have the same safety features! Features like a smart brake support system, blind spot monitoring, adaptive cruise control, a lane departure warning system, and a driver attention alert system are available on both models.

However, just like how the available technologies vary depending on trim level, the same is true for the available safety features. Just because you can find a safety feature on a sedan trim level doesn't mean that the same feature will be available on the same trim level for the hatchback.



2023 MAZDA3 SEDAN VS. HATCHBACK DIFFERENCES

While there are a lot of things similar between the Mazda3 Hatchback and the Mazda3 Sedan, that doesn't mean everything is the same. We've highlighted three of the most notable differences between the Mazda3 Sedan vs. Hatchback for you here.

SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS

The most notable difference between the Mazda3 Hatchback vs. the Sedan is their overall shape and size. Of course, there's a notable difference with the obvious difference in shape, but there's also a difference in the length of the two vehicles.

When we take a look at the 2023 Mazda3 Sedan vs. Hatchback dimensions, the Mazda3 Sedan is a bit longer than the Mazda3 Hatchback, measuring 184" long while the Mazda3 Hatchback is 176" long.

CARGO SPACE

While the Mazda3 Sedan is a bit longer than the Mazda3 Hatchback, when it comes to cargo space, the Hatchback still has the advantage. The 2023 Mazda3 Hatchback features 20.1 cubic feet of cargo space, while the 2023 Mazda3 Sedan has just 13.2 cubic feet of storage space. While both vehicles feature the same height, the Mazda3 Hatchback extends that height further back, which is why it has nearly double the cargo space despite eight fewer inches of length.

VISIBILITY

It's not something you're likely to think about when comparing the Mazda3 Sedan vs. Hatchback, but there's a big difference in visibility. That's because with a Mazda3 Hatchback, there's a much larger window in the rear.

Meanwhile, you don't have poor visibility in a Mazda3 Sedan, but with a smaller rear view window and more prominent frames throughout, you don't get near the same amount of visibility you get with the hatchback.

Still, compared to many other vehicles on the market today both the hatchback and sedan models provide outstanding visibility. This is especially true when you consider that both models come standard with a backup camera, and both models have an available 360-degree backup camera on higher trim levels!

Moreover, advanced safety features like blind spot monitoring with rear cross-traffic alerts help keep you safe if there is a vehicle in your blind spot while you're trying to merge on the road.



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
