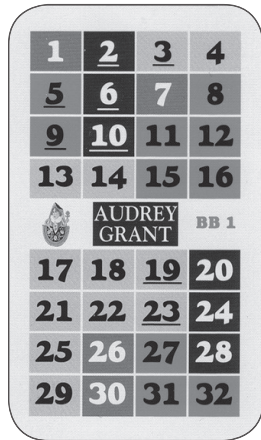


## *Audrey's Coded Cards*

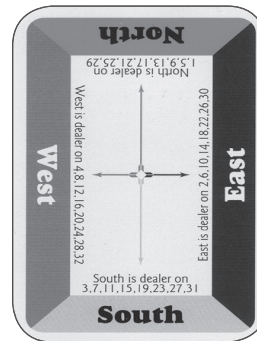


For each book in the Basic series there is a companion deck of color-coded cards available (see page 206) which is designed to make it easy to deal and play all thirty-two practice deals.

To use the cards, place the guide card that accompanies the deck in the center of the table.

Distribute each of the cards according to the color-coding on the back. To distribute

Deal #7, for example, look at the box numbered 7 on the back of each card. If the box is red, the card goes to North; if it is blue, the card goes to East; yellow goes to South; green goes to West.



Check that each player has thirteen cards. The dealer is indicated by an underline of the number in the box. It is also indicated on the guide card. The deal is then ready to be bid and played... and replayed as often as desired.

If you are practicing by yourself, turn all four hand face up on the table, dummy style (see page 7) and walk through the bidding and play, using the text as a guide where necessary.

If you don't have the color-coded cards available, sort a deck of cards into suits and construct the four hands one suit at a time.
