1. What are the driver requirements?

Minimum Age 23

Must have two years CDL licensed experience for the appropriate class of business - Driving similar equipment Maximum of 3 moving violations, or 2 moving violations & 1 accident in 3 years

No Major Violations (Reckless, DWI, DUI, Leaving the Scene of an Accident) within the past 10 years

2. How much will I make?

Company drivers are paid 25% of each load. Right now, the average load price is \$575 (varies depending on distance to the well). Generally, you will get between 1 and 3 loads per day. The average load count per week is 14. We do have drivers' that get more loads than that regularly, but 14 is the average.

Owner operators are paid 70% per load if they pull a Bobeaux trailer and 80% if they pull their own trailer. Average load count is 14 per week- average load price is \$575.

3. What is the schedule?

The work schedule is 21 days on- 7 off. You can stay out as long as you want, we do not require you take the days off.

4. Does Bobeaux do slip seating?

No, all drivers sleep in their trucks and park their trucks during home time.

5. What region will I be in?

Almost all of Bobeaux's work, right now, is in Southeast New Mexico and West Texas.

6. Does Bobeaux have their own mechanic shops?

Yes, there is a shop in Midland and a shop in Carlsbad.

7. What kind of trailers?

Right now, the majority of the work is box work. We do pneumatics as well.

8. Will I be paid demurrage or detention pay?

There is demurrage pay on some of the wells. The hourly amount and wait time are negotiated differently with each company.

9. What is the pay schedule?

Week one- Training

Week two-Friday you are paid training pay at \$50 a day.

Week three-Friday you are paid any loads you ran training week.

Week four-Friday you are paid your first full week of running loads.

You are always one week in the hole to allow time for auditing. The pay week ends Friday at 11:59pm.

10. How long is training?

4 days unless you have Oilfield Certifications (H2S, Fit, CPR, and Safe Land). Training is paid at \$50 a day. (Please see Orientation Packet for more info on training.)

11. Is this a 1099 position?

Company drivers and drivers for owner operators (who are not the owner), receive a W-2. Owner operators are 1099 employees.

12. Is there company insurance?

Not at this time.

13. What type of equipment will I be driving?

14. The majority of the fleet is 2013 International Prostars with 10 speed transmissions. There is a variety of other trucks and transmissions as well.

You will need to arrive at:

On the scheduled Monday at 9 am for orientation. Bobeaux will provide lodging Monday night thru Wednesday night. Bobeaux does not guarantee an available bed Sunday night. We have a bunkroom with 7 available beds. These beds are on a first come first serve basis for Sunday night. You are responsible for your own transportation from the airport or bus station. Three are cabs and uber available at the airport.

Note: All of the paper work and almost all of the training is completed in Midland, Texas.

Required documents for the hiring process:

- 1. A voided check or direct deposit instructions from your bank.
- 2. Driver's license and social security card.
- 3. Short and long form medical cards. (You can get a long form from your doctor if you do not have it.)
- 4. Bedding (sheets, blanket, towel, pillow etc.)

You must provide:

- 1. Steel toe boots.
- 2. Fire Retardant clothing (pants and long sleeved shirt, or full coveralls.) You can purchase these items at Walmart, Boot Barn, Cavender's, or any safety-clothing store.
- 3. Smart phone- This is needed for Transflo, which is how your tickets are scanned. This allows you and Bobeaux to be paid. You will also need a smart phone for the Keep Trucking app.

All other PPE (Personal Protection Equipment) will be provided.

*Day 2- safety orientation, trailer training, Instruction on the Keep trucking app (ELD), Transflo

documentation, and proper truck blower use...

*Day 3-AJT safety training Part I, H2S training, Fit test, Safe Land (PEC), and CPR

*Day 4 AJT safety training Part II –Then new hires go to Carlsbad for Watco orientation and additional

safety training.

Orientation starts on Monday – you will leave the Midland facility on Thursday and drive to Carlsbad.

In Carlsbad, you will complete the rest of your orientation and start your 5-load training on regular

percentage pay.

Drivers are paid 25% of the load-1-2 sometimes 3 loads per day

The work schedule is flexible -work as long as you want to work.

Be prepared for the conditions out here- It is hot at the well, and cold in the winter. Lease roads are

poorly maintained.

will get you certified.
