HomeGroup and Personal Study Questions

1. How do you measure your value to God? What about your value to others?
2. Read 2 Timothy 2:19-20. How do you interpret this passage of Scripture? What is your personal application?
3. Hebrews chapter 11 is the famous “Faith Hall of Fame” narrative. While we might be familiar with the more well-known names, the writer mentions a group of “nameless” faith heroes as well (see Heb. 11:36-40). After reading this passage, what are your thoughts about these *Unknowns*?
4. How important is it to have your efforts and contributions recognized? Explain your response.
5. The Apostle Paul writes to the church in Corinth about spiritual gifts (1 Cor. 12) and explains that we are “many parts” of a single body. What does this mean to you? How pertinent is this teaching to understanding the importance of your role within the Kingdom of God? Can you explain your thoughts?
6. What is your greatest takeaway from our teaching today? Why does it speak to you?
7. What do you hear God teaching you through this lesson? How will you respond?
