HOMEGROUP & PERSONAL STUDY QUESTIONS

1. How do you feel about the historical evidence of the resurrection outside of the Biblical accounts? Does it matter to you? Why or why not? What if the resurrection never happened? What does that mean to you?
2. The Apostle Paul writes (1 Cor. 15:12-19) if there is no resurrection, Christians are a most pitiful people. Why do you think he makes this remark? What emotions do his remarks evoke in you?
3. Pastor Bill made a point in our Easter teaching that, “the resurrection changed everything.” Can you explain what the resurrection has changed for you?
4. Pastor Bill also declared the resurrection is deeply personal. In what ways is the resurrection deeply personal for you?
5. While the resurrection offers the promise of eternal life to us after death, the question might be asked what does it offer for you today? Can you describe how the resurrection impacts your life on a daily basis?
6. Easter completes our Defining the Relationship series. Have there been any significant moments or teachings during this series that have “redefined” your relationship with Jesus? What are those moments/teachings? How have they changed your relationship? What will you do in response to those changes?
