HOMEGROUP & PERSONAL STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Pastor Bill asked the question, “what if you were made for both— both high altitude (theological) perspectives and ‘boots on the ground’ faith?” What do you imagine when you think of “high altitude perspectives” and “boots on the ground” faith?
2. Discuss the idea that “Jesus is the most complete revelation of Jesus that we have.”
3. Pastor Jeff made a very powerful statement, saying, “We (believers) are called to be the incarnations of Jesus.” Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Please provide reasoning for your position.
4. Examine your faith and your Christian maturity in the shadow of the Bible’s definition of love (1 Cor. 13:4-8). How do you fare? Are there areas you feel God is guiding you to grow? Do you think this passage of Scripture is a fair example to be measured by? Please explain.
5. Romans 12:1 exhorts that we offer our whole lives as living sacrifices to God. What does this specifically mean to you? How would you describe your life as a “living sacrifice” a “truly acceptable form of worship”?
6. In light of our teaching series, does the idea of a sacrament confuse you? How would you describe a sacrament to someone? What do you think about you being the greatest sacrament?
